National Alumni Council Meeting

A meeting of the National Alumni Council was held on January 7, 2000. President Dick Capobianco '53 provided an overview of the Alumni Association's strategic plan. He stressed the purpose of the Alumni Association, which, in part, includes efforts to:

- expand alumni involvement
- aid in admission recruiting
- create Bryant College "ambassadors"
- create and maintain avenues of communication with alumni
- offer professional, personal, and educational development
- encourage alumni financial support
- increase alumni networking opportunities

During the next three to five years, the Association's Executive Committee will review, refine, and develop recommendations on the implementation of the plan.

Alumni involvement is key to the success of the plan. With that in mind, two committees have been formed to meet alumni needs:

Ray Grigelevich '91 will chair the Benefits and Services Committee, which will assist the Office of Alumni Relations in developing products and services that benefit alumni.

Dana Bradley '92 and Ron Cioe '67 are co-chairmen for the Community Service Projects Committee. This committee will develop a prototype service project which other chapters can replicate. The committee will also review the development of a procedure manual for launching similar events.

Alumni Association's Strategic Plan

The Alumni Association comprises all Bryant alumni. The National Alumni Council (NAC) represents the gender, ethnicity, and demographics of the regional chapters, student leaders, staff, and members-at-large. In January 1999, NAC voted to create and implement a strategic plan for the Alumni Association that supports the College's initiatives.

What this means to you

Simply put, the Alumni Association's goals include getting Bryant alumni more involved with their alma mater. The first step of such an action plan is to identify the College's strengths and weaknesses, as well as identifying the demographics of the alumni base. Here are highlights of what we have learned from your responses to an alumni survey conducted by an independent consulting firm in 1998.

Historically speaking

Bryant's biggest challenge is that, despite its 136-year history, the present campus in Smithfield is 28 years old. In college years, that's considered young and not enough time for multiple family generations to have developed strong ties to the campus. Bryant alumni are primarily first generation college graduates so there

is no allegiance of family legacies encouraging children to attend their parents' college. Additionally, a Bryant education has long been considered a transaction, a four-year rung on the career ladder.

That's not to say, however, that Bryant graduates never look back. Overall, alumni are proud to be Bryant graduates. As students, they found lifelong friends in their fellow classmates. They have a high interest in alumni events and services.

Strategic Plan Goals

The primary goal of the alumni association's strategic plan is to reinforce the connection between Bryant and its alumni. Objectives include increasing the number of alumni volunteers and the recognition of those alumni, and developing events, programs, services, and benefits for Bryant alumni.

The details
