Increase In Annual Support Reported

Alumni, parents and friends are supporting the College and its future as never before, reports trustee Joseph T. Duffy '69, Chair of the Institutional Advancement Committee of the Board of Trustees. Highlights shared at the January Board meeting include:

- Operating fund goal for the year is \$814,000 of which 48% has already been committed.
- Total dollars are up **76%** for fiscal year 1998 (August 1, 1997-July 31, 1998).
- Alumni commitments have **increased 125%** over the same period for 1997.
- The number of alumni making commitments **increased by 33%**.
- Participation among parents has more than doubled, with total gifts to date at **\$32,120**.
- The telefund program has raised \$211,396 in individual gifts and pledges as of January, 1998.
- The President's Leadership Council (\$1000+ donors) has welcomed **53 new members** since August 1; goal was to reach 50 new members by July 31, 1998.

- The women's volleyball team reached the NCAA Division II Tournament for the second time in four years this fall. The Bulldogs, who lost to New Haven 3 to 1 in the tournament, were the only non-scholarship team in the 32-team field.
- The men's golf team, currently ranked 22nd in the division, shoot for their 12th consecutive NCAA Division II Tournament bid this spring.
