 - Set goals for future

 - Has met twice, two students from the group will sit on this council (Olivia Valenti, '21, Chris Albino, '20)
 - Will provide real time information and recommendations from students
- IV. #BryantInclusionDay CIE kickoff program, pledge, book club with HR, President words, Inclusion cards very popular
- V. BIAS Incident Committee
 - Committee composed of six members, balance of genders, and multidivisional
 - Policies and practices review summary available at library, list of at least 20 recommendations, items reviewed included
 - Communication challenges, reporting challenges
 - Structural challenges, faculty involvement, training
 - Spelling out what a BIAS is, transparency of process

- Education for committee members EverFi, Unconscious Bias
- Bryant.edu/bias revamped
- VI. Faculty Development Series
 - Collaboration between HR, SA, and AA
