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FORT OGLETHORPE, GEORGIA

12.45 AM. Dear Folks, Jhave a few minutes & start this but don't know how long. This past week has been similar to the others with out much of interest. I went to two shows - Mae West in something or other - not very good-+ Covey thank again. Weddidn't win any ribbons at parade this week either; in fact, we all felt we did much better the week before. Pidd tell you that there is no chance of going to officers' candidate school for months + mouths? There isn't going to be another class untit March and there is a long waiting hot. So don't expect me to get to be an officer will you. We found out this week that one of the women in our barracks is a former editor of one of the sections of McCall's Magazine. They were taking

pictures of her and of our company for an article on her army fife which will appear in about the april issue of McCall. Hes Mane is Kathleer Robertson and she is about 45 & imagine. She seems very mee. We are planning a christmas Party for Friday evening and are going to have Christmas Trees (cedars!) on each floor of the barracks. going to have a meeting. will finish this later -Wed Dec 22 10.30 PM. Monday night when I expected to finish this letter, practically everyone in the barracks had to wash windows and were confined to the barracho for the evening because our daily inspection was so bad. Everything which is wrong is lested on a Delinquency Report and is called a 9.9. If there is tust on your bed, you get a gig. If your clothes are hung wrong, you get a gig. In fact, they can think of all sorts of things to give you 919s for.
