

The fortunes of the Bryant Basketball Team rose once again to the high level which has characterized Indian quintets of past years. After dropping three early season games, the warriors of the Orange and Black came along in fine style to finish the campaign in a tie for first place in the Conference with New Bedford Textile Institute. The courtmen entered the important playoff tilt crippled by a February graduation which took Captain Frank Turano and forward Gus Charos. After a valiant attempt the tribe fell before the strong-driving New Bedford club who emerged from the contest as the 1950-51 Southern New England Coastal Conference Champions.

As concrete evidence of the caliber of the Indian team was the selection of four men from Bryant on the Conference All-Star Team. Named to the first team were Ken Gillis and Ralph Seaburg, while Charlie Voetsch and Frank Turano placed on the second squad.

This loss to New Bedford in the playoff game gave the varsity a season's record of fifteen victories against only five set-backs. In league competition, their record was six wins and three defeats.




