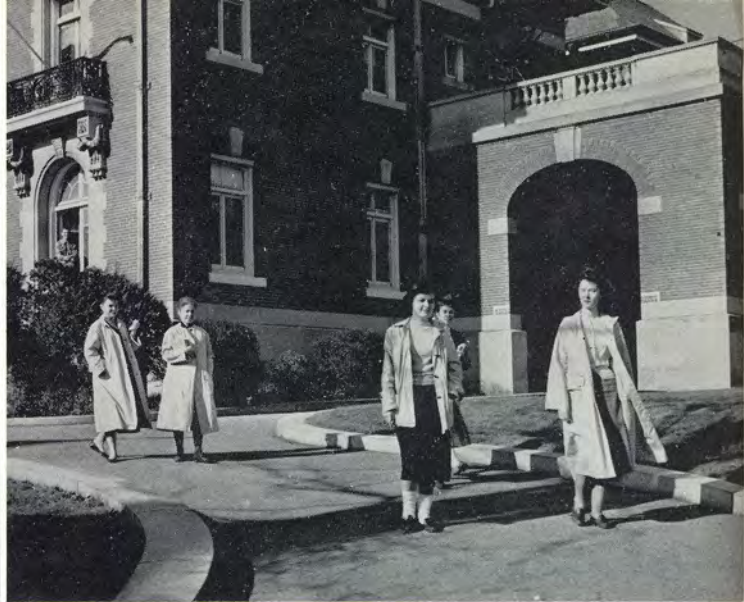
May the halls of this building always be used for purposes consistent with Thy divine plan and to Thine honor and glory.
