# 993-94 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



### MARY BURKE **Head Coach**

This is Mary's seventh year at Bryant, the last two as head coach. She began her coaching career here when she became an assistant to former coach Ralph Tomasso in 1987 shortly after graduating from Providence College.

During Mary's stint as an assistant from 1987 to 1991, the Bryant women won the Northeast-10 tournament (1987) and recorded a respectable 64-51 mark over four seasons.

Mary took over the head coaching reigns in 1991 and has taken Bryant to the conference playoffs the past two seasons.

An All-East basketball player at PC, she completed her career as the 2nd leading scorer in Lady Friar history with 1,672 points. She averaged 20 points and 6 rebounds per game en route to both Big East Conference and Kodak All-East honors.



### ED REILLY Head Coach

Coach Reilly is beginning his fifth season at Bryant. In the summer of 1989 he took on the assignment of rebuilding the Bryant basketball tradition. It hasn't been easy, but Reilly is determined to turn the program around. "I want to make the Bryant basketball program as well respected as Bryant's academic reputation," says Reilly.

Prior to becoming the first full-time basketball coach in the history of Bryant's Division II program, he spent a decade with some of the best basketball minds in the country-Joe Mullaney, Pete Carril, and George Blaney.

After two years as a high school coach at Kingswood Prep in Connecticut, he became Mullaney's assistant at Brown University in 1978. In 1980 he went to Princeton to work for Carril, one of the nation's college coaching deans, before returning to his alma mater at Holy Cross in 1982 as Blaney's top assistant, a position he held for seven years before taking over the Bryant program.


