Our Honorary Degree Recipients

W. STUART SYMINGTON

Formerly head of the Emerson Manufacturing Company in St. Louis, one of the largest manufacturers of radio and electrical equipment in the United States; consultant to the Army; chairman of the Surplus Property Board; and Assistant Secretary of War for Air. Since September, 1947, the first Secretary of the Air Force. As president of the Emerson Manufacturing Company, he formulated successful labor relations policies which attracted national attention.

J. HOWARD McGRATH

Formerly City Solicitor of Central Falls, Rhode Island, United States Attorney for the District of Rhode Island, was three times Governor of Rhode Island, Trustee of the Rhode Island Charities Trust, and Solicitor General of the United States. At present, United States Senator from Rhode Island, and chairman of the Democratic National Committee.

COLONEL EDWARD J. W. PROFFITT

Served in World Wars I and II; served as a member of the Claims Board of the War Department, Assistant to the President of the Emergency Fleet Corporation and assistant counsel, United States Shipping Board; transferred to the United States Treasury, assistant to Director of Budget and legal aide to Chief Coordinator. At present advisor on bond investments to the Manufacturers and Traders Trust Company of Buffalo, New York.

ELLIS GIBBS ARNALL

Formerly Attorney General and Governor of Georgia; author of "The Shore Dimly Seen" and "What the People Want", the latter written as a result of a 75,000 mile trip through the United States; a courageous objector to racial and religious intolerance. As governor of Georgia he successfully fought the attempted overthrow, by force, of the government of the state, and proved that the courts can stand as a defense for constitutional government.

HOWARD SHIRLEY PALMER

Formerly president of the National Railway Accounting Officers Association; at present President of the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad Company, a trustee and member of the Governing Board of the National Conference Board, New York City, and a director of other companies representing transportation, hotel, banking and insurance interests.
