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## Letter Written by Katherine Trickey to Her Folks Dated June 18, 1944

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Sunday, Jun 18th. 9.30 PM. [1944]

Dear Folks I finally got a chance to mail the Card I wrote implainfield when larried in atlanta! I wade such good connections I did not have time until them. I had quite a trip down. I did not sleep any Wed nesday night except for shoot fine minute no po , so had to take a nap Thursday afternoon. aren't those youngsters adoraly Walter, you ought to see Bobby get around Now. He hitches limselfall over the house,) Never saw anything like it at was so funny. He is such a good vatured baby. I left at 7.15 pm. got the train at Plainfield al 7.28 Rode from Plainfield to Elizabeth with Phil Friend! Amagine Meeting any one familian way off there.
Changed trains at Elizabeth for Newark.

Jeft Newark for Washington at 8, 45 AM,

Comforfable to trip that far. Had just time (100pm.

to catch the attanka train. I got into a air-conditioned

coach but that was the only good feature. Hwas so crowded that there were at least 30 people more than seats in each coach. The boys were sitting everywhere - on top of the water cooler on teach shelf of the baggage compartment and in the cupboard above the boggage compartment and on suchcases and barracks bags all up the aisles. The seats in both the Ments room and the ladies room were full. I sat on mysnitcase until 4.00 AM when I finally got a soat We arrived at atlanta 8.30 Am. Took train for Macon at 10.15 AM spent time in between eating breakfast axad walking around the business section, God to Mason at 1.15 PM. ate during in Macon, went shopping and bought nea pair of blue shorts. Sot out to camp about 3, 30 PM. It was so good & see everyone, but it is even hottes than when I left: Marjorie & I went to the movies to see Mark Twain last might. Very good picture based on Wark Twain's life. Today I have washed & would, and loafiel around, We had a swell pienic to night. Fifteen of no including Capl Stokes + ft Duvall took sandwickes + salad + cookies out in the woods back of the barrocks. We slayed out until 9.00 P. M talking + singing . One of the garls

had a uhelele. Lots of fun. Not too buggy. If D wall is being transferred & Foot Knox, have her go and to are wondering who the new lieutenant will be and what she will be like. Not any other changes. Things seem fust as usual. almost as if I had never been home. It seems almost I certainly couldn't have had a better furlaugh Thanks for everything. I have put the Bar Harbor preture on the ledge and am sitting facing it. It makes me cooler fust to look at it. Love to all
