PARENTS WEEKEND

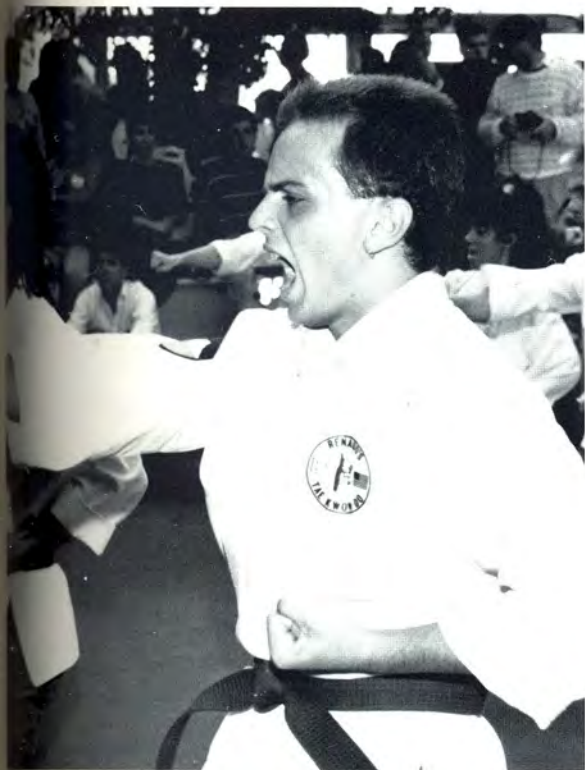

Karate Club

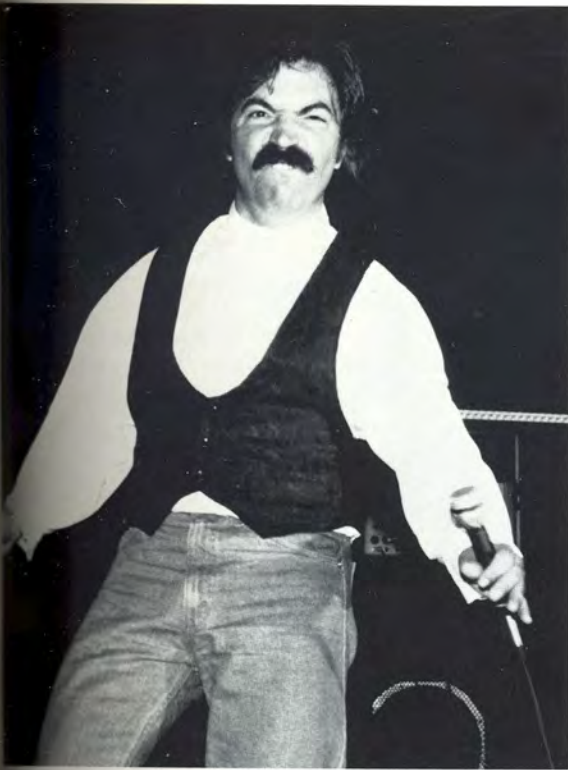

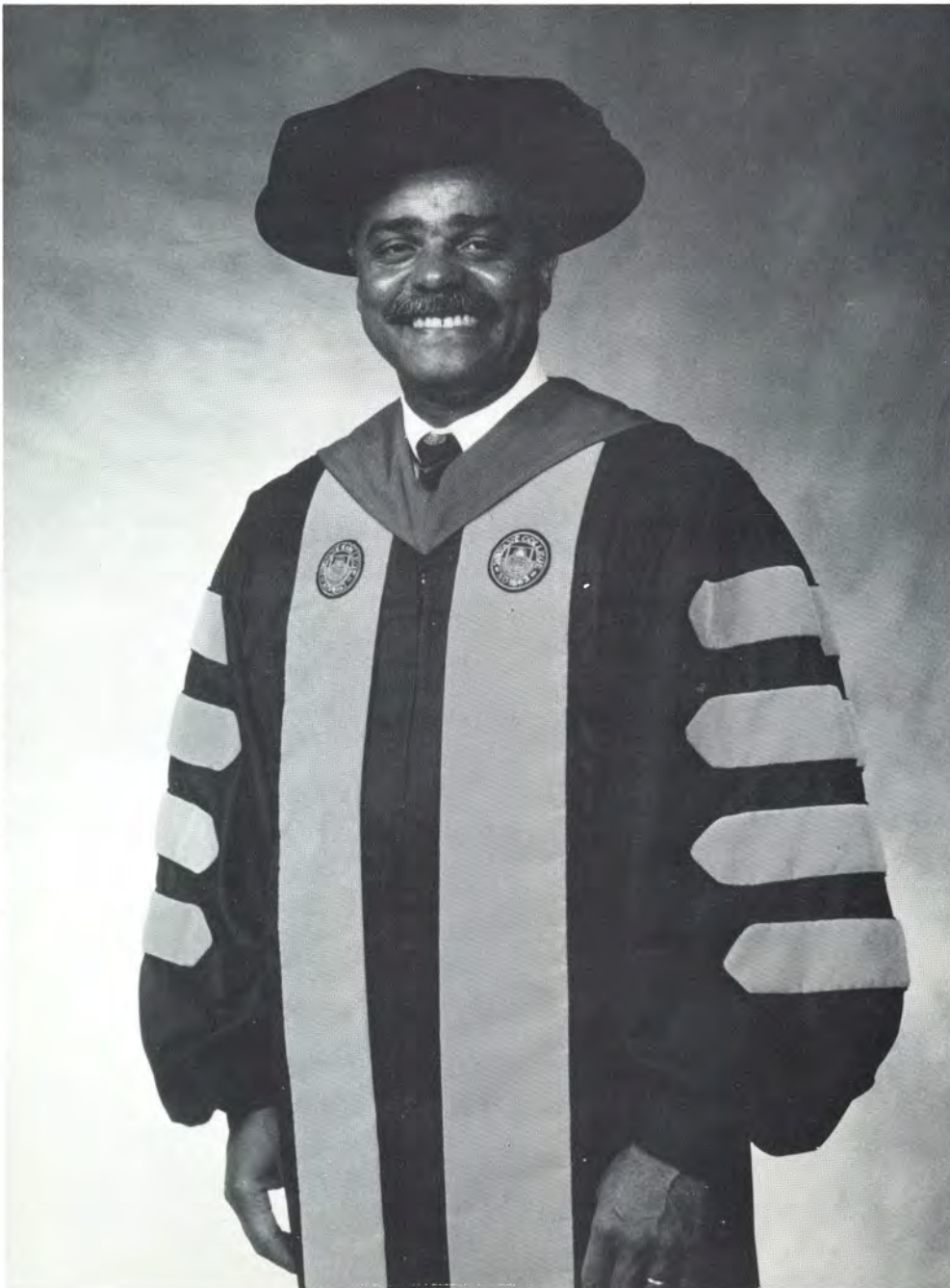


Passing the Torch

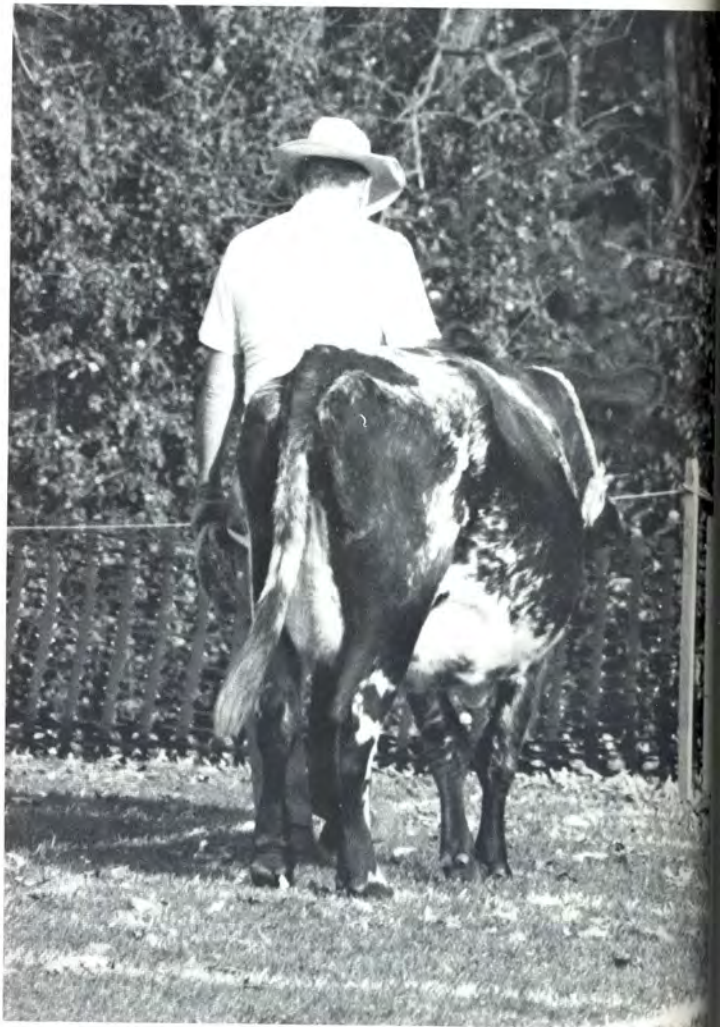
Country Club Weekend

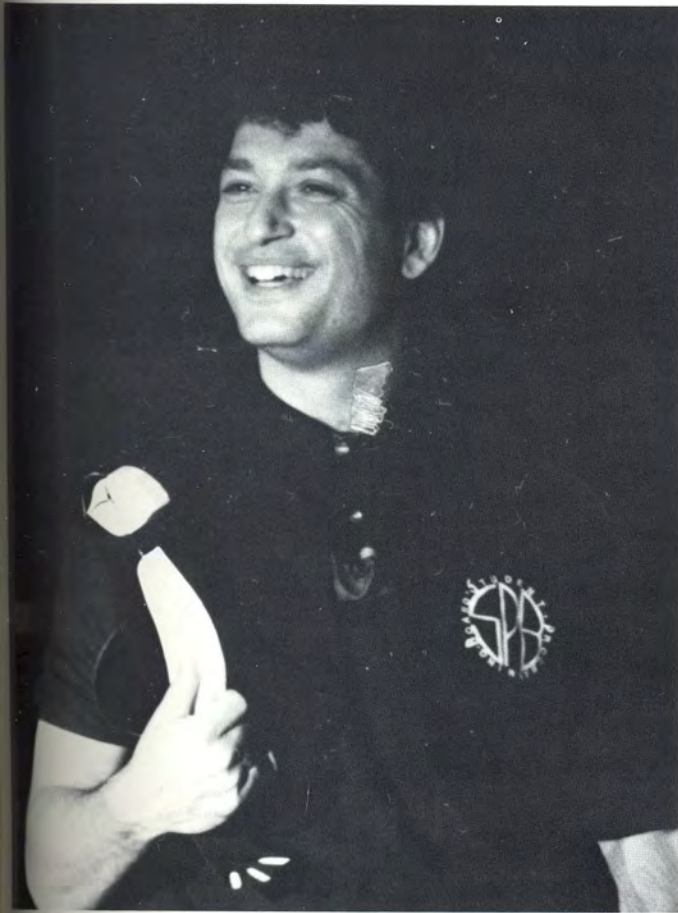


UNHOMECOMING WEEKEND

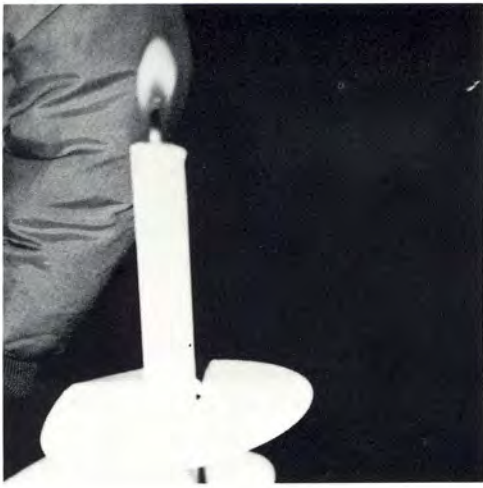




Howie Mandel

Festival of Lights

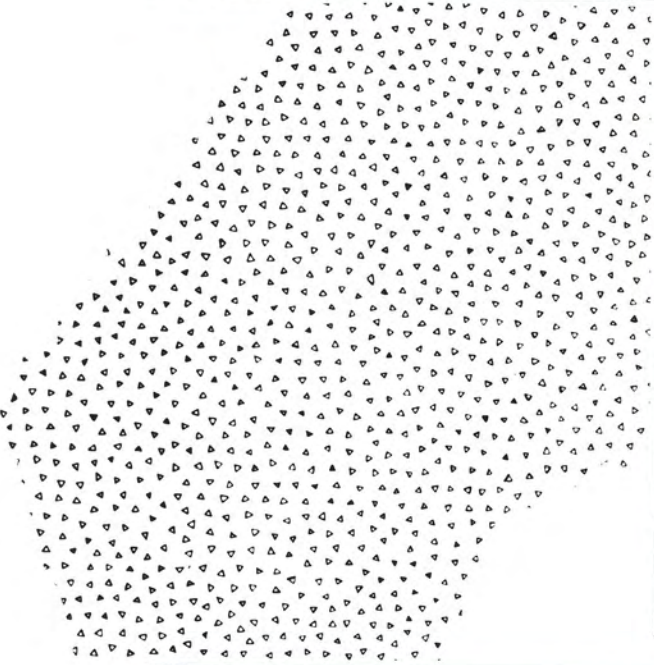

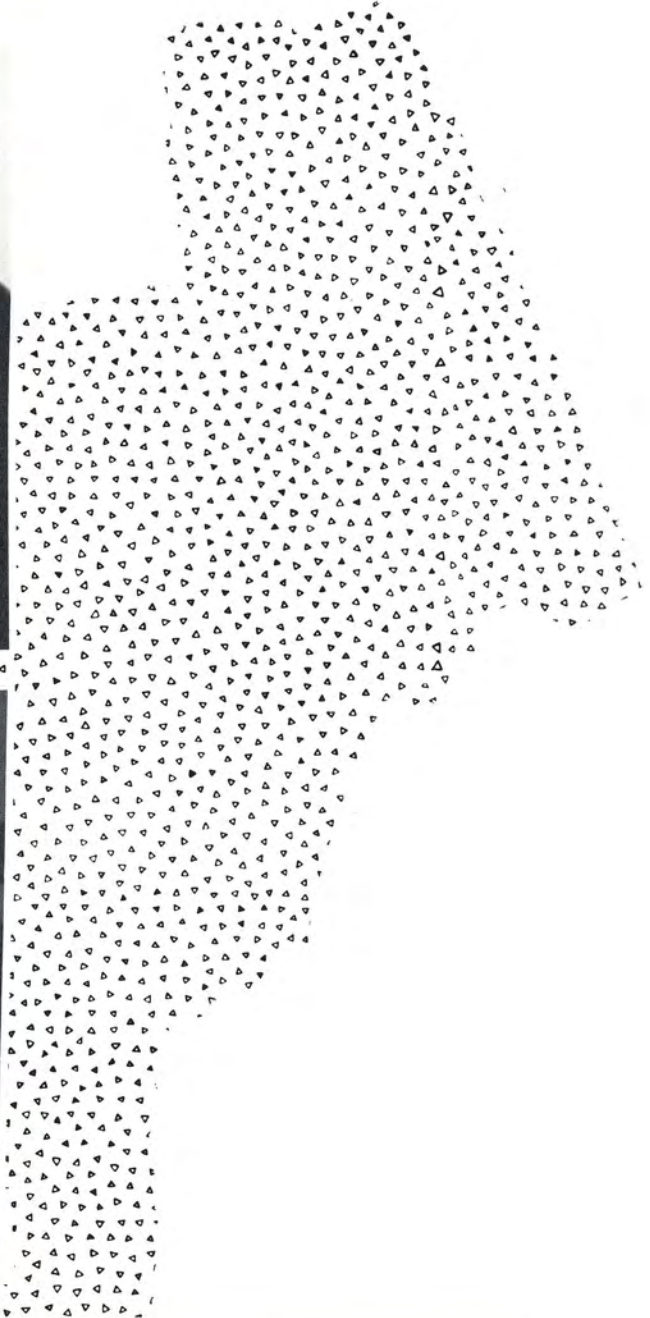


Senior Christmas Party

OXFORD DEBATE

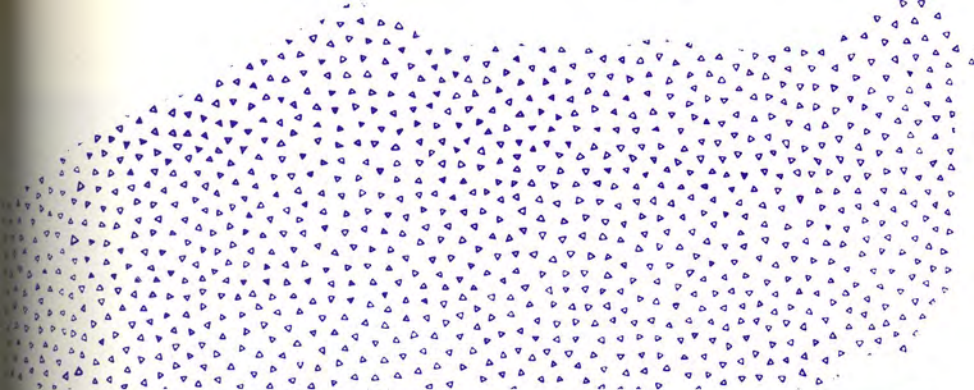

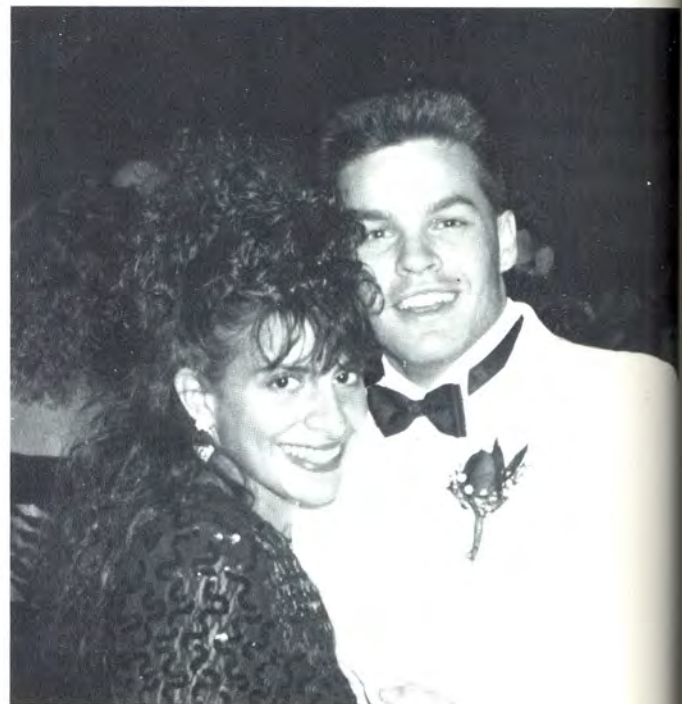


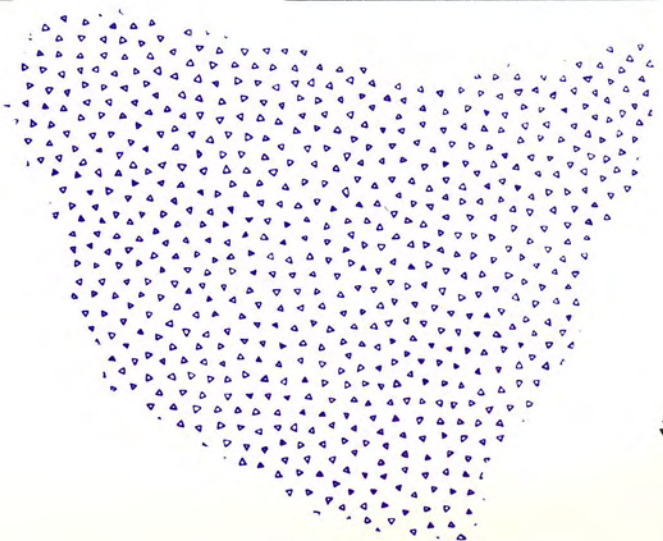
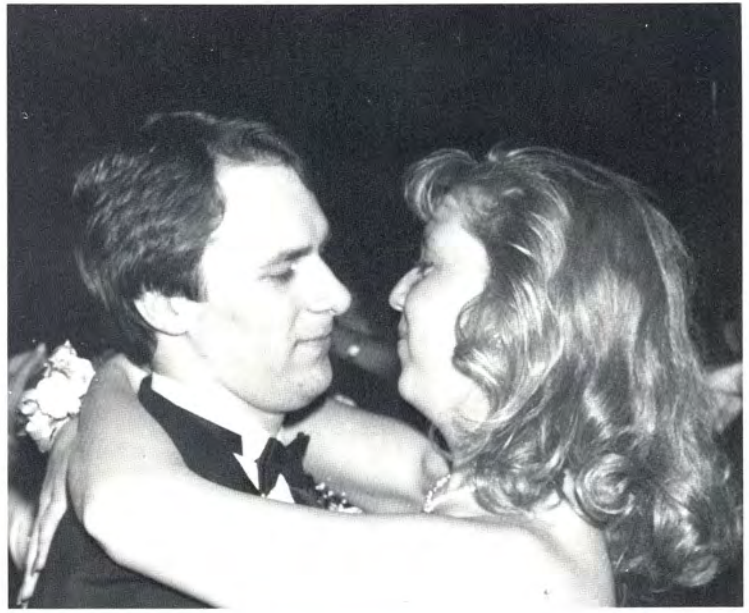


SENIOR BANQUET

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

As students arrived on campus in September of 1989, they were welcomed by not only new faces, but also by old faces in new colors. The familiar red and black of Tau Epsilon (TE) had been replaced by the black and gold of Phi Kappa Sigma (Φ K Σ). The significant colors of purple and gold typically seen on a member of Phi Epsilon Pi (Φ E Π) were replaced by the letters Σ Φ E (Sigma Phi Epsilon). Red and buff were now seen on the officially recognized members of the Delta Chi Fraternity (Δ X). Change was arriving and coming quickly.

After the introduction of a national sorority, Alpha Phi (Δ Φ), many of the local sororities followed and became affiliated with other national sororities. Sigma Lambda Theta (Σ Λ Θ) is still known as "Theta", but rather as Theta Phi Alpha (Θ Φ Λ). The blue and white of Sigma Iota Beta (Σ I B) has been replaced by the pink and green of Delta Zeta (Δ Z),

and Alpha Phi Kappa (Δ Φ K) members now proudly wear the letters of Phi Sigma Sigma (Φ Σ Σ).

These changes did not occur willingly, but rather out of necessity and the desire to survive as an organization. Due to the increased awareness of problems and trouble areas in Greek communities nationwide, administrators had to ask local fraternities and sororities to affiliate with national organizations to lessen the insurance and liability burdens. So far, the change has gone well. After KT (Kappa Tau) affiliated with Phi Kappa Tau (Φ K T), only three of ten fraternities remain local, and one of five sororities maintains its status as a local.

The switch from local to national has not been easy. The colors of the old are sometimes worn with the letters of the new, because Greeks should never forget their pasts and should always look out for what lies in the future.

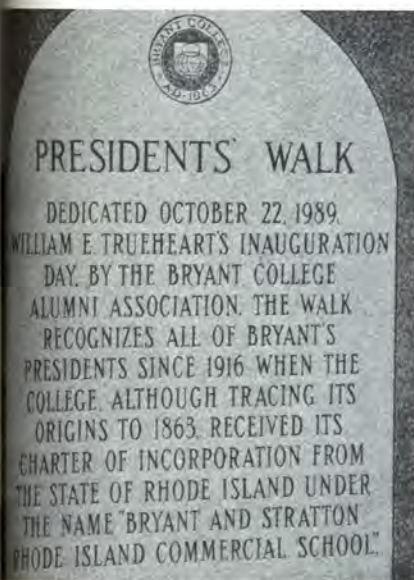
