5 Aug 1944

Dear Folks,

Just a note. It is noon time to go to work.

Not much of news. Marjorie + I went to town Thursday. I got my stripes on and Marjorie got a haircut. Then we ate at the New Yorker + went to a show. "Chip off the Old Block" We found we'd both seen it, but it was clever enough for us both to like it even better a second time. Last night we mowed + cut the lawn around the barracks. It was very natural to be using a lawn mower again and rather good. The lawn is about like ours at camp! for roughness, however.

I got my Date Dress yesterday. an 18 1/2 fits perfectly except for length. It's swell. And going to town tonight with Kerner + Marjorie for dinner + show.

Tomorrow afternoon + evening. our
detachment is having a picnic at a
country estate about ten miles from
Macon. private swimming pool. It
sounds fun. I'm looking forward
to it
