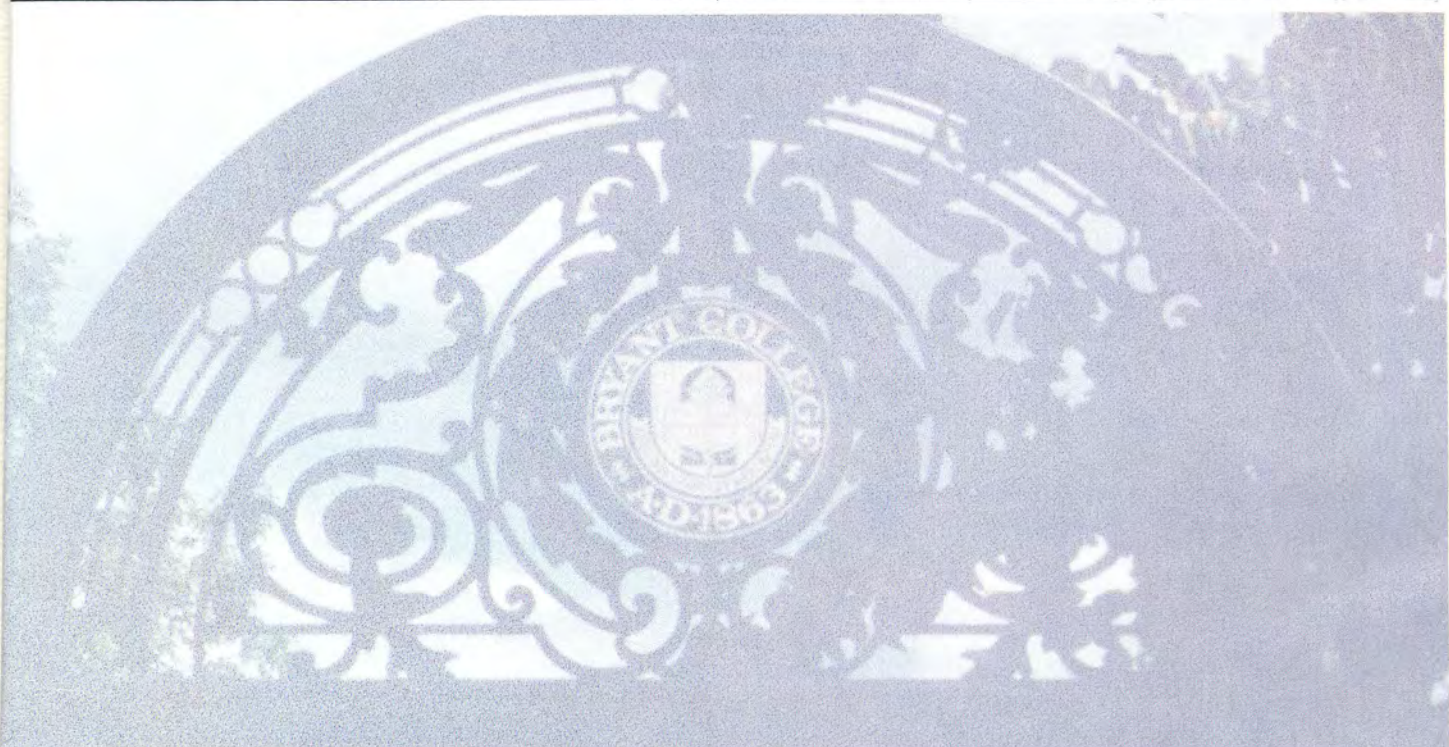

THE ARCHWAY TRADITION

THE ARCHWAY, WHICH FRAMED THE MAIN ENTRANCE TO SOUTH HALL ON BRYANT'S EAST SIDE CAMPUS, WAS THE GATEWAY THROUGH WHICH ALL GRADUATES PASSED ON COMMENCEMENT DAY. THE WROUGHT-IRON ARCH WAS MOVED FROM THE OLD CAMPUS IN PROVIDENCE TO THIS LOCATION ON THE TUPPER CAMPUS IN 1971, AND SERVES AS THE ONE PHYSICAL LINK BETWEEN THE OLD AND NEW CAMPUSES.

WORN PATHWAYS ON EITHER SIDE OF THE ARCHWAY SHOWED RESPECT FOR THE TRADITIONAL BELIEF THAT STUDENTS WOULD NOT GRADUATE IF THEY PASSED THROUGH THE ARCHWAY BEFORE COMMENCEMENT WALKWAY '87, FUNDED BY THE CLASS OF 1987, WAS BUILT TO REPLACE THE PATHS AND ENCOURAGE STUDENTS TO PRESERVE THIS TRADITION.



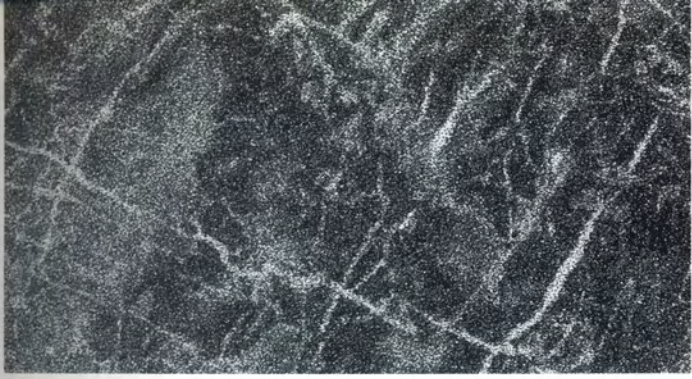

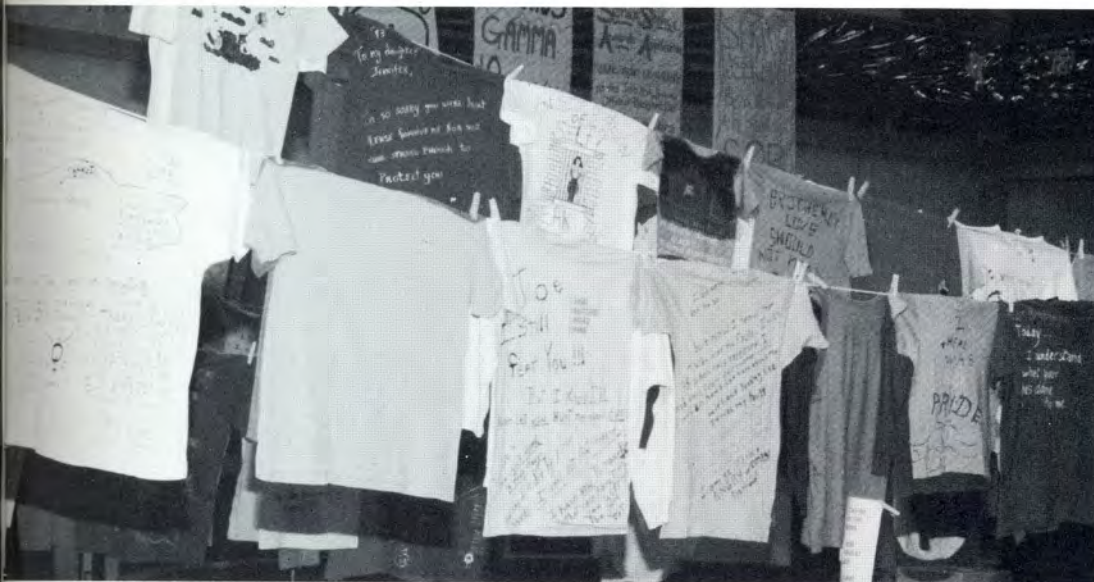


THE CLOTHESLINE PROJECT

The Clothesline Project is a national movement which publicly exposes the different forms of violence that women experience in American culture. It bears witness to the issues of Rape, Domestic Violence, Incest, Child Sexual Assault, Stalking and Murder. It is comprised of different colored shirts representing the different forms of violence, which are decorated by survivors and family and friends of victims. Shirts are collected by regional Clothesline Projects around the country and displayed in public or a personal setting visible to all victims and survivors of this type of violence.

The purpose of the Clothesline Project is two fold. It gives survivors and friends and families of victims an opportunity to safely and confidentially speak out about the abuse. Few avenues exist today where women can speak openly and honestly about the personal impact of this type of experience. Making a shirt and hanging it on a line for the public to see, becomes an integral component of a woman's healing process. And the process has many layers. The decision to first make a shirt. The shirt making process itself. Letting go and giving their shirt to the project, and finally seeing their story hang in it public witness with the stories of other women, viewed by friends and strangers alike.

Secondly, the purpose of the Clothesline Project is to educate the public about the personal impact and prevalence of this type of violence. It is the first national movement of its kind that links together the different forms of violence, speaking to the quality of life all women have to live with in this culture. Hanging the shirts for the public to see gives a voice to an experience that for too long has remained a silent and destructive force in our culture. It moves those who see it in ways no other forum on violence against women has, because it brings us in touch with the personal side of violence. It puts a human face on a problem that, in its own way is as invisible as AIDS was a decade ago.

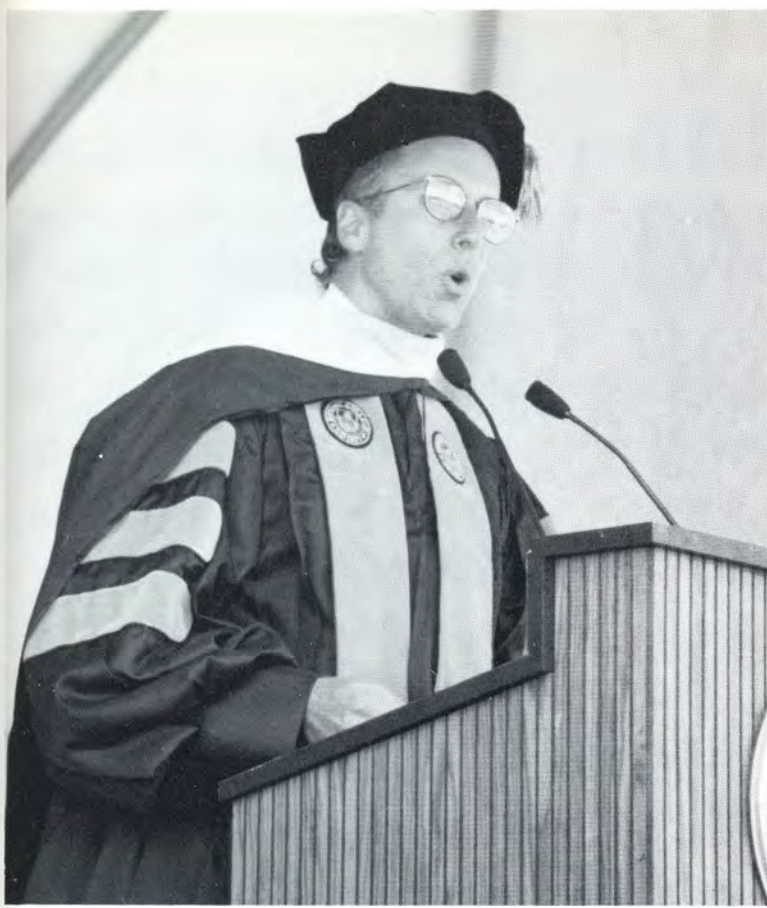




Commencement 1995

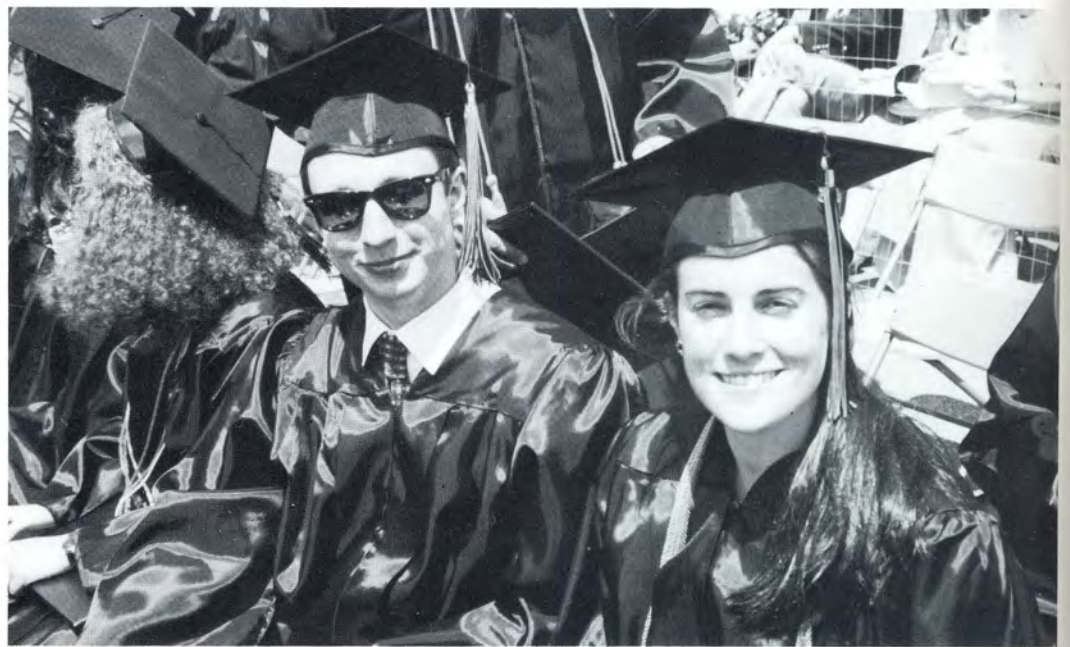


Left: The Commencement speaker for the Class of 1995 was Lawrence K Fish the Chairman, President and Chief Executive officer of Citizens Financial Group.

And it is time for a picture seniors. Put your beers down and show that Octoberfest spirit.



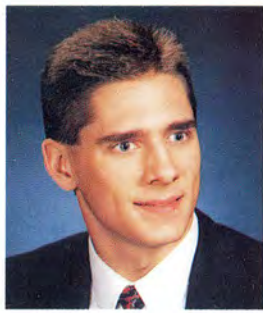

The Alpha Beta Chapter of Kappa Delta Phi Fraternity has gone through many changes over the past 48 years. Founded in 1947 by veterans of the second world war, Chi Gamma Iota was a local fraternity which was made up of men who primarily had service in the military. It was on June 2, 1968 that Chi Gamma Iota decided to become a colony of the Delta Sigma Phi national fraternity and later, in 1971, to become a chapter of this national fraternity.

A small national with 14 active chapters in the New England area, Kappa Delta Phi was founded primarily as a teachers Fraternity but has since expanded. On January 29, 1994, the local Fraternity Delta Sigma Chi became the Alpha Beta chapter of the Kappa Delta Phi National Fraternity.

We have always persevered as a strong group of men that are bonded together by the loyalty of brotherhood and common experiences during our college years. 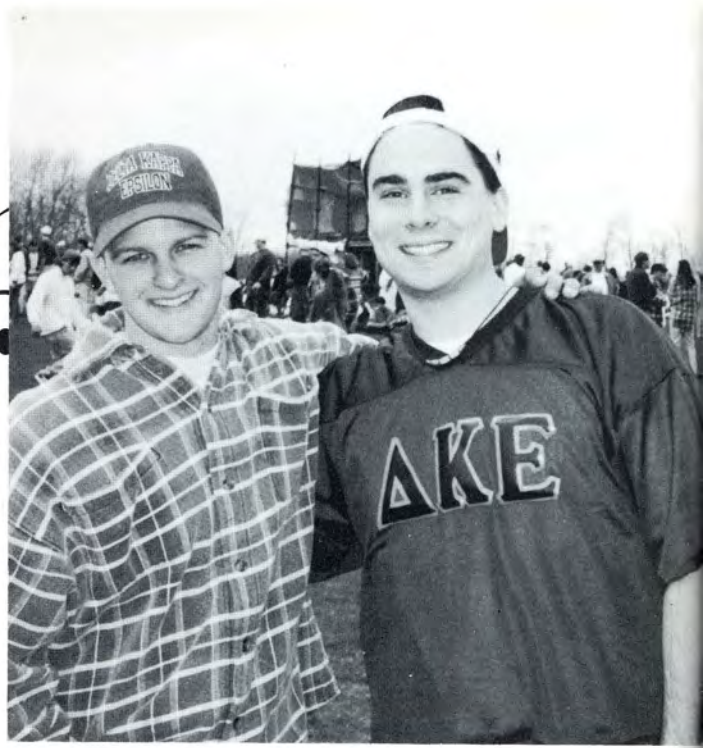

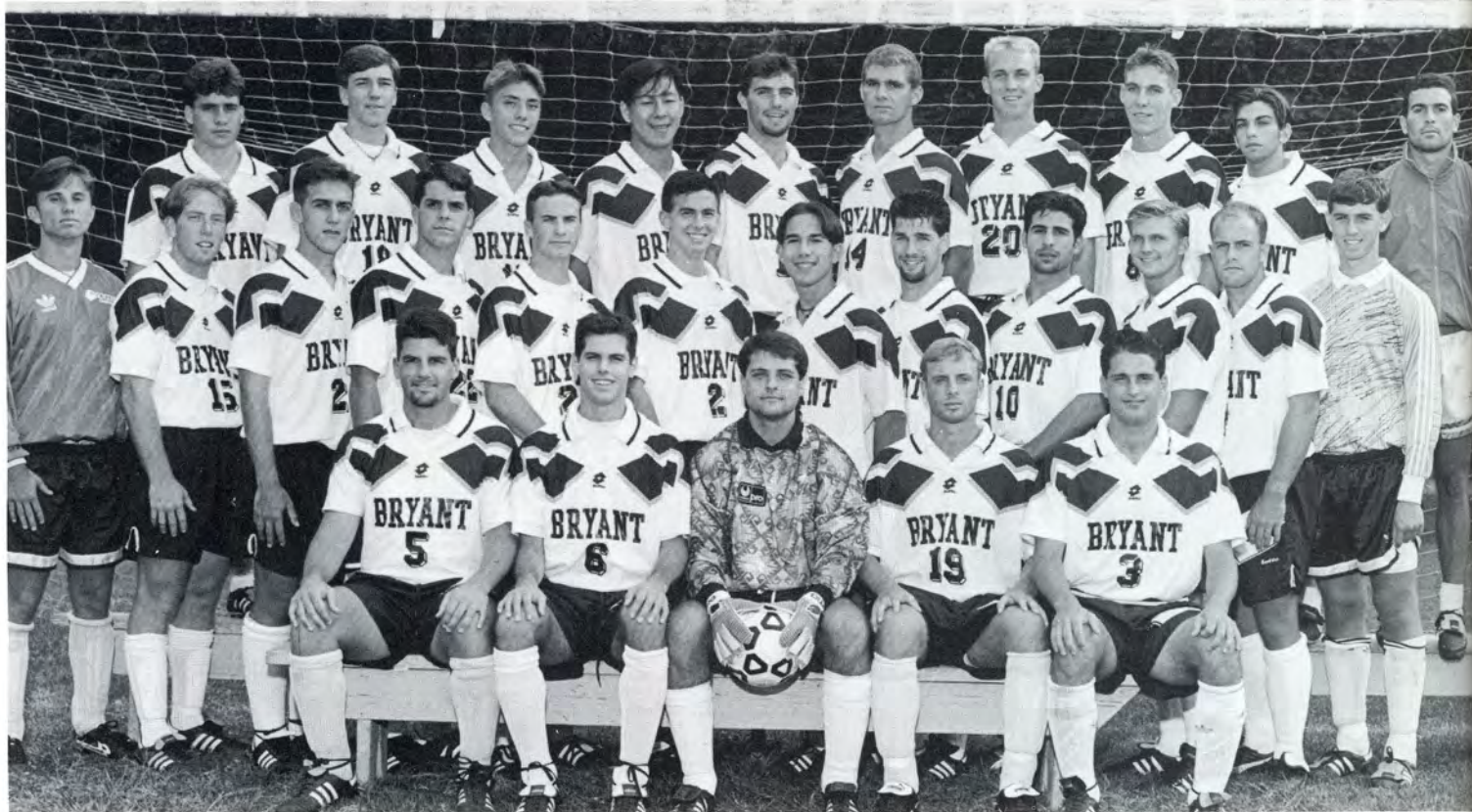

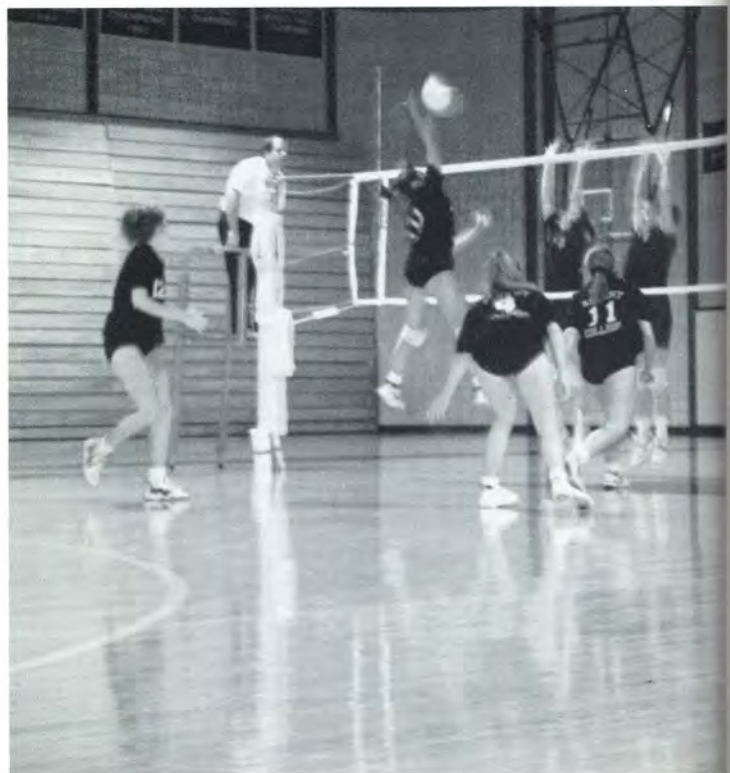

sier and Lisa Sarandopolis received North-east-10 First Team All Conference honors. Best of luck to next years team and congratulations to the graduating seniors.

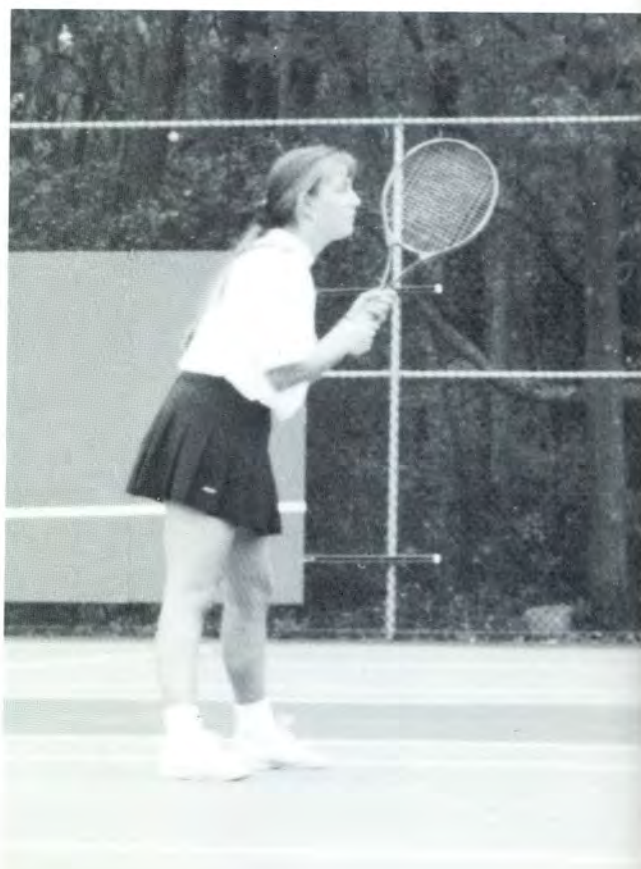

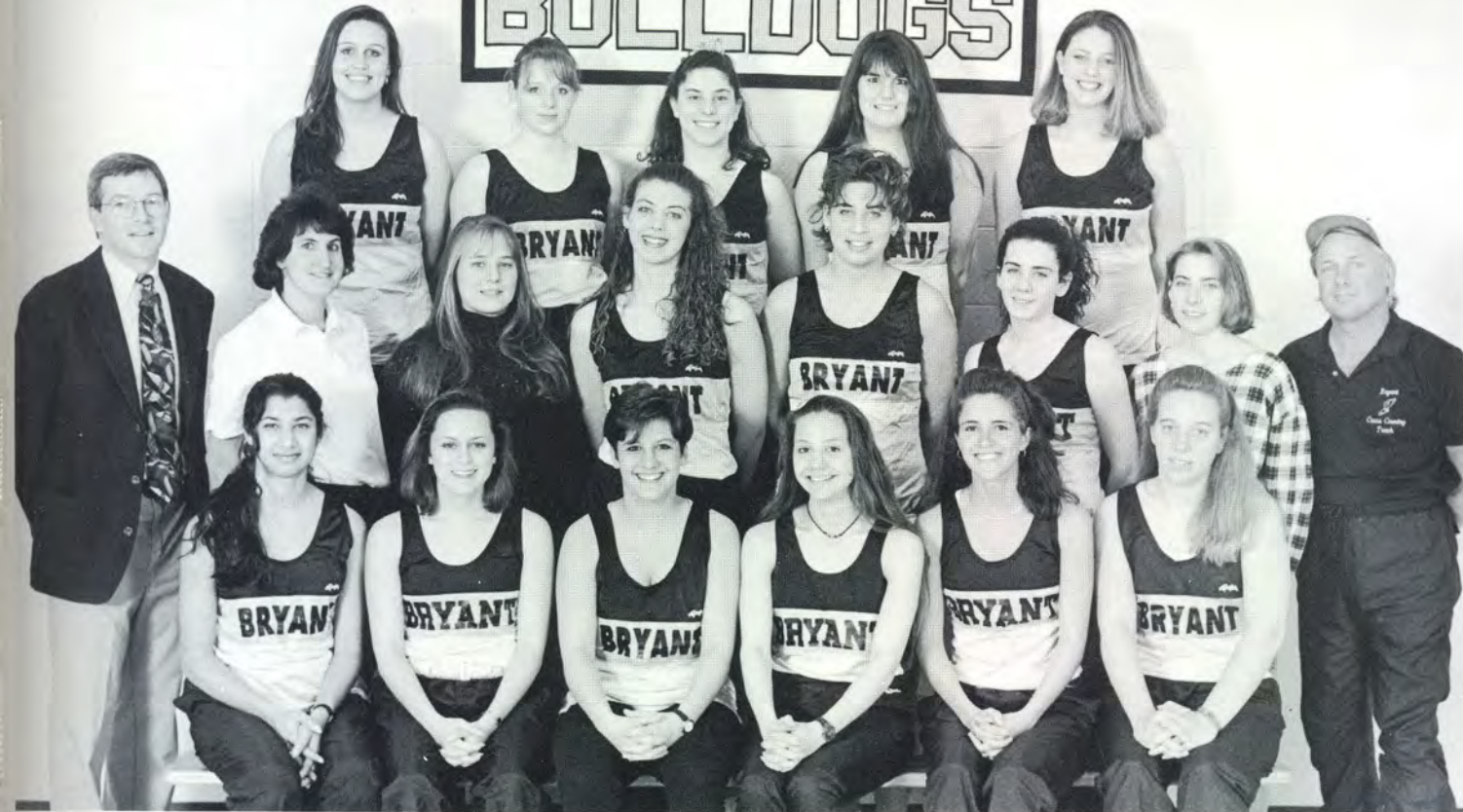

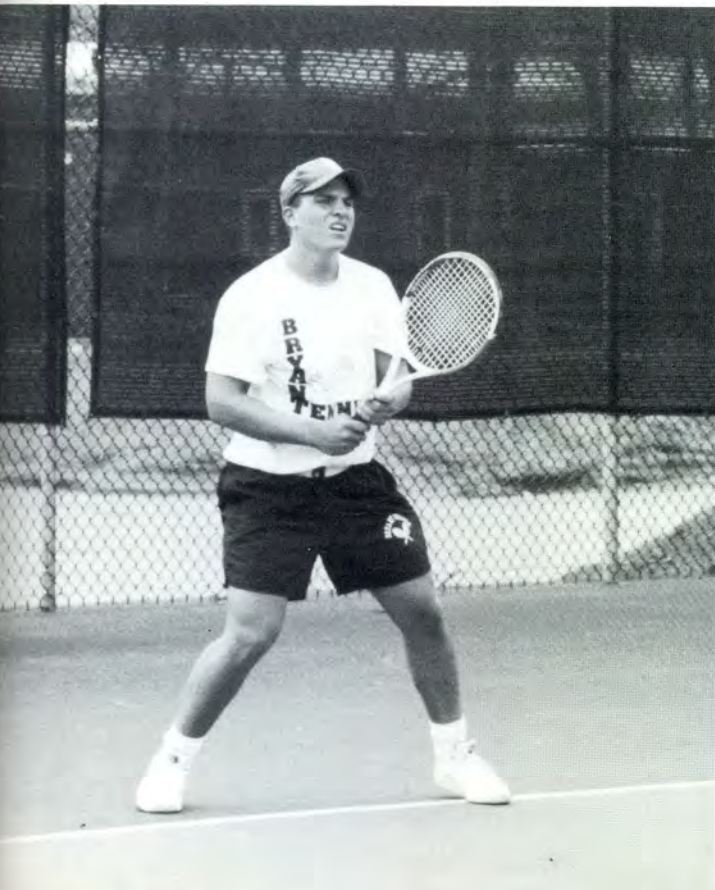

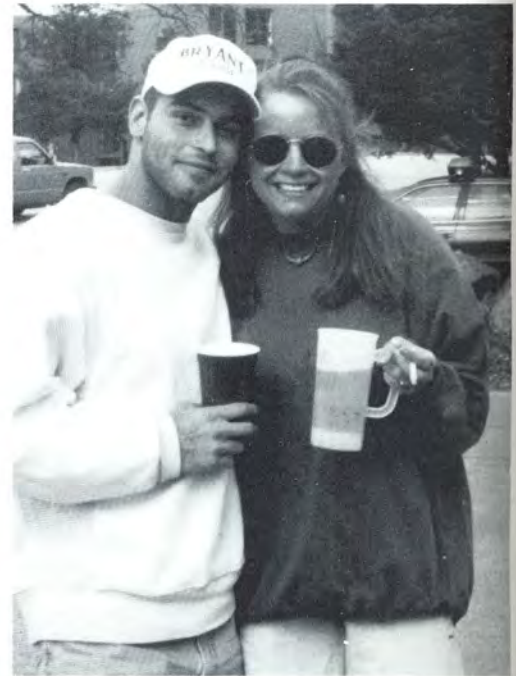


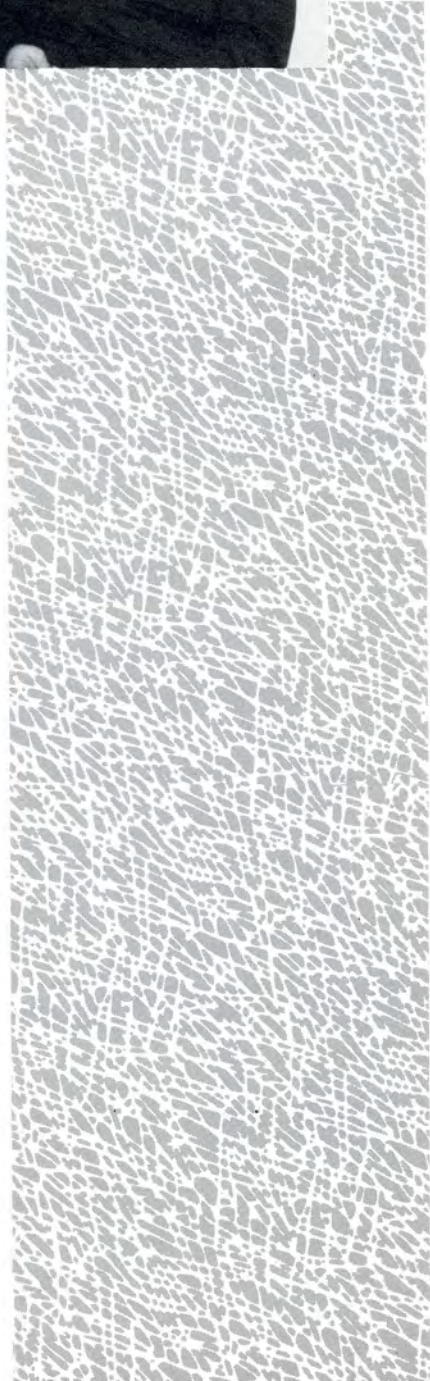














T


