A Silver Anniversary in Smithfield

ryant College moved to the Smithfield campus in the Fall of 1971. It ushered in a significant period of expansion for Bryant. No longer defined by the physical constraints of its former Providence location, the College was free to achieve a level of distinction its founders could never have imagined. Original Smithfield buildings included the Unistructure, center of all academic life. what is now called the Koffler Technology Center, and residence halls. 


Bryant Center Celebrates 10 years





FESTIVAL OF LIGHTS

Here, at Bryant, the Festival of Lights is a time when people of various religious backgrounds come together to celebrate the holidays. Students, Faculty, Staff, and Alumni join in singing songs, such as, *Rudolph the Red Nosed Reindeer, Silent Night*, and *Eight Bright Candles*. Prayers are offered by the Protestant, Catholic, and Jewish Faiths.

In addition, the Jewish holiday, Hannukkah is celebrated with the symbolic lighting of the Menorah. This holiday commemorates the miracle that occurred in an ancient ransacked Temple. The Everlasting Light, which should burn continuosly, only had enough oil to burn for one day. Miraculaously, the oil burned, not for one day, but for eight days until new oil could be obtained. In remeberance of this miracle, one candle on the Menorah is lit during each day of Hannukkah.

As the festival continues in the Unistructure, the light of the Menorah is spread from person to person. As the light grows and becomes stronger, a parade is led from the Unistructure to the Bryant Cemter, where the festival is concluded with the lighting of the Christmas tree, caroling, and hot chocolate.










17th Annual Northern


"Ace-ing their way to the Top"




































































Editor's Letter
