I can't win many games from her, but she has to fight for most of the points so Lonet mind losing, I am mich surprise de to think I can hit the balls at all; it has been so long since I have played. I've done much better than I expected to, believe me. I only hope I can keep tup as well as I have begun, It's been heaps of fun to play again.
