Dear Folks,

Not much news this week. I had a very nice letter from Roger yesterday which I shall try to answer tomorrow. Isn't it nice they are going to be near home for a while anyway.

Wasn't that sad about Mrs. Crowell? I enjoyed her so much. ~~Wasn't~~ Remember when she taught our Sunday School Class/ We all liked her as a teacher.

We couldn't get enough girls for a team this week so I guess our basketball season is over. I shan't mind too much as it will be light enough to play tennis after supper in just a short time now I think.

I saw the best movie this week. I even sat through it twice. "Music for Millions" with Margaret O'Brien playing the lead. I think that youngster is a marvel. All of the cast was good. Jose Iturbi lead the symphony orchestra and played several piano selections. There wasn't as much music as I should have enjoyed but much more than there usually is. The story was rather sad but very human, with many humorous spots.

I sent Mr. Somers \$11.00 to cover the next two payments on the car so that I'll not have to think of it again until July. I suppose I will have around \$25 to pay on my income tax from last year. Dad, will they bill us for that last payment or will they expect us to ~~re~~ remember the amount?

So warm in here now that we have all the windows and doors open. It is a wonderful sunny day outside. Wish I had the afternoon off. I'm snatching a few minutes so that this will go out today instead of Monday.
