Firstcome first obvice. 3 of us. I Da Helfand. Pol Massert I went in Dot's car! We heard Robert Wheele The Methopolitan barolone. He was grand. Jeryoyd every number of it. He is tall + slightly stout with a beard but a very pleasing stage presence. It was good not to have to want for buses. I feldalmost like a civilian for a few hours! Thursday, I went by myself to town and did some shopping; ate at the 5+5 Cafeteria; and
