Dear Falls,

Sat again and payday
and the afternoon off! not
bad, not bad at all. I'm
going in town to see if I can
buy some underclothes and
a pair of shorts.

I went to a Good Friday
Cantata at the Presbyterian
Church last night after Glee
Club. ~~It~~ was fairly good - but
it was so warm and stuffy
I could scarcely stay awake.

I stayed home both Wed
& Thursday evenings which is
quite a record for me. Played
tennis a while Wed evening

I'm enclosing a money order
for \$20.00 which I hope will
cover the cost of painting the
car and maybe give you a
few dollars for anything else
you wish - I wish it could
be more but I am sending
\$25 to college again which
will finish that bill at last.
