The trainees were marching back to camp and they were singing_ at the detachment, it was quiet Many of the girls had gone out, and Those left were listening to the sadios! about 9 o'clock, Il Kennedy Came around and invited us all to said the mess hall for an impromptu snach, Some of us went down and brought back sandwickes late for a barraches premie and we've been enjoying ourselves ever sence! I just wish it meant well be going home soon - but I'm afraid it will be Easter at least

before we're thousagh. - There are Many Many to be Lischarge and some one is going to have to to the paper work - I expect we're the Dies who are going to Loist of course, the war is over for the Civilians - not for the armed forces! all the broadcasts tonight kept emphasezing - I day holiday for whom - The civilians, Meletary personnel report for work as usual!! Who won this war, anyway and review soon. That will be all the time off we'll get I im agine!!

Oh well, we should worry, so long as it's over. It has been hard the last few Jays while we wanted for the friend word. - Today I took one of the girl's radio to the office and we listened allday - I can't even remember when I wrote last! I hope idwasn't too long ago. Boy - I wish I were leaving for home tonight - We all do, - as you Can well imagine. Despect there will be many boys who will to so.
