Tues.
18 Sept 1945

Dear Folks,

I had a very very quiet week-end
My room was cool enough to really enjoy.
I slept and read Sat afternoon + evening -
worked at the office Sunday morning - slept
again Sunday afternoon and then cleaned
out my wall lockers + foot lockers Sunday
evening. I found enough junk to fill
a box to send home. so I send a box
this morning by Railway Express - It will
come collect. - I haven't any bills with
me as I write this but will send some
money in the next letter to take care of
the expenses. There are some things
in the box for you all - Use what

you want, - Most of the rest
are souvenirs -

Dad, I'm taking shorthand
two evenings a week - starting last
week - and am enjoying it! Not
as difficult as I believed it was!!

Must stop now
