A cordial welcome to relatives, friends, students, faculty, and alumni who gather here today to celebrate Bryant College's One Hundred and Twelfth Commencement.

Academic Heraldry

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn today in these Commencement Exercises are patterned after the attire of monks and students in the Middle Ages. Those who have earned the bachelor's degree wear a gown and a semistiff yoke, long pleated front, intricate shirring across the shoulders and back, which is also distinguished by long, pointed sleeves. The holder of a master's degree wears a similar gown, with long or short oblong sleeves which hang down in the traditional manner and open at the wrist. Those possessing the doctor's degree wear gowns with broad velvet panels down the front and three velvet bars on the full, round, open sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the field of learning represented by the degree.

Most of the colors and meanings of the costumes are found in the hoods. These are silk-lined with the color or colors of the institution conferring the degree. The border of the hood is velvet and its color signifies the field of learning to which the degree pertains.

Honorary Degrees



DOCTOR OF SCIENCE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

W. RUSSELL BOSS

Chairman of the Board, A. T. Cross Company

Born in Providence, Mr. Boss was reared in Cranston, Rhode Island, graduating from the latter city's high school where he was a member of their hockey and tennis teams. He joined the family-owned A. T. Cross Pencil Company in 1937. It was then a small firm housed in Providence. After World War II, this company began to introduce new ideas and in 1953 became the first manufacturer in the world to have a completely matching ballpoint pen and matching mechanical propel-repel pencil set. Its sales grew to over thirty-eight million dollars in 1974. In 1964 the company moved to Lincoln, Rhode Island and he became President. Now occupies over 140,000 square feet and has 850 employees. Expansion of the company also led to a plant in Ireland, 17,500 square feet in size and with 85 employees. In 1971, Mr. Boss became Chairman of the Board when the Cross stock became public. He is a champion sailor and sports car racing enthusiast. He participated in the Sebring Twelve-Hour Endurance Race, finishing in the Top Ten three times. A well-known philanthropist, he has been a director of the Beach Pond Camps, the Jimmy Fund, R. I. Association for the Blind, Narragansett Preservation Society and is presently on the Board of the Fort Lauderdale Oral School (school for deaf children). He has also been active in many campaigns for the Boy Scouts, YMCA, the United Way and Save the Bay and has contributed many local scholarships to worthy and needy students.



DOCTOR OF SCIENCE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

GEORGE CLIFFORD CRAIG

Dean of Admissions and Secretary of the Corporation, Bryant College

A native of Rhode Island, Dean Craig was graduated from Burrillville High School and is a past president of its Alumni Association. Associated with Bryant College for forty-seven years, he came as a student and was graduated with the degree of Bachelor of Science in Business Administration. He was president of his class and a member of Beta Sigma Chi Fraternity. He became College Bursar, then Admissions Counselor. During this time he also did some part-time laboratory teaching and placement work for the College. He resided for many years in West Hartford, Connecticut where he served Bryant as Admissions Counselor in that state as well as in New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania and the entire Southern New England area. While a resident of Connecticut, he served as chairman of the West Hartford Education Fund Committee and a leader of youth activities in that area. He was appointed Dean of Admissions for the College and in June of 1968 was awarded the Honorary Degree of Master of Science in Business Administration (M.B.A.). In August of 1973, he was named Secretary of the Corporation of the College by the Board of Trustees, continuing in his capacity as Dean of Admissions.

DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS

ALFRED HAHN JOSLIN

Associate Justice of Supreme Court of Rhode Island

Born in Providence, Rhode Island, Judge Joslin received his early education in Providence Public Schools and Mercersburg Academy. He was graduated with honors from Brown University and Harvard Law School. He is a member of Phi Beta Kappa. After three years of military service, he was released with the rank of Lieutenant Commander. He served as Chairman of the Executive Committee of the American Bar Association for Rhode Island and also in the same capacity for the Junior Bar Conference. He was a Trustee and Vice Chancellor and is now a Fellow and Secretary of the Brown University Corporation. He received the Big Brother of the Year Award in 1957. A former president of the Providence Community Fund, he was also chairman of the Rhode Island United Fund Budget Committee; trustee and president of Butler Hospital; trustee and secretary of Miriam Hospital and a trustee of Temple Emanuel. He was a director of the Greater Providence YMCA, the Jewish Community Center, the R. I. Division of the National Conference of Christians and Jews, the Narragansett Council Boy Scouts of America, the Jewish Federation of Rhode Island, the Old Stone Bank, and the Mortgage Guarantee and Title Company of Rhode Island. Judge Joslin was a member of the Commission to revise corporation laws and election laws for this state. He also served as delegate to the limited Constitutional Convention in 1958. He has been Associate Justice of the Rhode Island Supreme Court since 1963.



DOCTOR OF SCIENCE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

JOHN FRANCIS MCGILLICUDDY

President, Manufacturers Hanover Trust Company

A native of Harrison, New York, Mr. McGillicuddy was graduated from that town's high school and went on to earn his degrees from Princeton University and Law Degree from Harvard Law School. He served in the U. S. Navy, leaving with rank of Lieutenant (j. g.) in 1958, the same year in which he began his banking career at Manufacturers Hanover Trust. In 1966 he was elected senior vice-president in charge of the bank's western region and appointed to the administrative board in 1969. Advancing to Executive Vice-President and Assistant to the Chairman, he became Vice-Chairman and Director in 1970 and President in 1971.

Mr. McGillicuddy is a director of Cities Service Company, Kraft Corporation, the Sperry and Hutchinson Company, Reynolds Metals Company, Westinghouse Electric Corporation and the Continental Corporation. His memberships and directorships include the Association of Reserve City Bankers, the Roosevelt Hospital, the National Football Foundation and Hall of Fame, Inc., treasurer of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society, the Economic Development Council of New York City and the N. Y. Chamber of Commerce and Industry. He is also a member of the campaign committee for the United Negro College Fund, and the United Fund of Greater New York, as well as Co-Chairman of the Cardinal's Committee For Education, advisory group to Cardinal Cooke on Catholic Education. In May of 1973 the College of New Rochelle conferred on Mr. McGillicuddy the honorary degree of Doctor of Humane Letters.

DOCTOR OF SCIENCE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

JOHN HUNTER SLATER

*Founder and Former Chairman and President of
Slater Food Service Management*

Born in Bovina, New York, the son of Reverend Thomas M. Slater, D.D., and Anna Hunter Slater, John Slater and his family moved to Seattle, Washington where he was educated in the public schools, prior to entering the University of Washington. Moving with his family to Montclair, New Jersey, he entered the University of Pennsylvania where he became an instructor in English before his graduation from the University. While a student and instructor he resided at Delta Kappa Epsilon fraternity house, engaged in numerous campus activities and competed on the University track team. He was graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree in Economics. He subsequently accepted a position teaching English and coaching the track team at Muhlenberg College in Allentown, Pennsylvania. During the weekends he engaged in graduate studies at the University of Pennsylvania. Dissatisfied with the food and service, he took over the operation of the kitchen. Ultimately, food-service management became his full time career. Slater Food Service Management was incorporated in 1931. This organization became active in nearly every state in the union and many foreign countries. Over 100 schools and colleges were serviced as well as scores of hospitals. In 1961, the Company was acquired by ARA, whose expansion has been phenomenal with sales exceeding a billion dollars. John H. Slater is currently living in Naples, Florida where he has extensive interests in Marine Life.



DOCTOR OF SCIENCE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

ANTHONY S. STASIO

Chief Counsel for Advocacy, United States Small Business Administration

Born in Boston, Massachusetts, Mr. Stasio received his early education in that city. He was graduated from Bryant College in 1950 with the degree of Bachelor of Science in Accounting and Finance. A veteran of World War II, he served the United States Marine Corps for five years. Beginning his business career in 1947 in Rhode Island, he rose to office manager and became a licensed public accountant prior to entering government service in the Small Business Administration in 1957. In this department he served successively as Loan Examiner, Financial Specialist, Branch Manager and Regional Director in Providence, Rhode Island. He went on to the Regional Directorship of New York and advanced to Washington, D.C. as Director of Management Assistance, Director of Economic Development and as Deputy Associate Administrator for Finance on the national level. He has received citations on numerous occasions by local, state and federal government organizations as well as by civic officials. Mr. Stasio is a member of the Urban League of R. I., the R. I. Historical Society, the American Legion, Past Department Commander's Association of R. I., the Bryant Alumni Association, the Accreditation Council for Accountancy, the Italian-American War Veterans of the U. S. and the Italian Executives of America, among many other professional and cultural organizations.

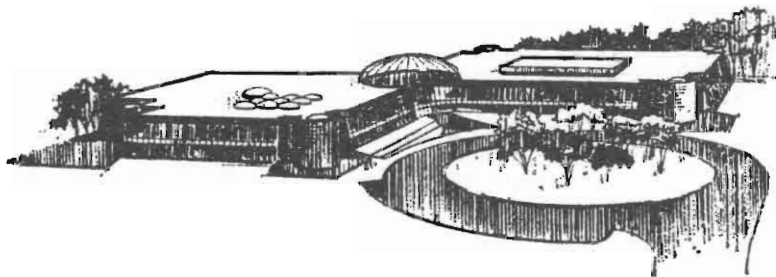
