DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS JAYNE BAKER SPAIN

Vice Chairman, United States Civil Service Commission

Citation

Jayne Baker Spain, industrialist, humanitarian, and public servant, your career is eloquent proof that women can and must play a vital role in business, social service, and government. For twenty years, you headed your own company, Alvey-Ferguson of Cincinatti, Ohio, an internationally known manufacturer of conveyor and unit handling equipment. Four years after its merger with Litton Industries, you became a director of the parent corporation, a tribute to your business acumen and your value as an advisor in the high councils of American industry. Your deep concern for the rehabilitation, training, and employment of the physically handicapped, and your splendid record of placing these individuals in worthwhile occupations, caused President Johnson to name you to the President's Committee on the Employment of the Handicapped in 1966 and President Nixon to reappoint you in 1969. You are presently serving as Vice Chairman of that Committee, having demonstrated in your own business and in others that handicapped persons properly trained and properly placed are not occupationally handicapped, and if given an equal opportunity will prove to be successful, and often superior, employees. On June 14, 1971, after nomination by the President and confirmation by the Senate, you became a member of the United States Civil Service Commission, the sixth woman in the Commission's eighty-eight year history, and you were also designated as Vice Chairman by the President. Frederick Clinton Williamson, public official, spokesman for human decency, and leader in the service of the underprivileged, long before the movement for civil rights and racial equality became fashionable in political and social circles, you were in the vanguard, pointing the way, goading the conscience of your fellow citizens, and proving by your life and works that minority group persons could attain distinction in their chosen fields of endeavor. For twenty-seven years you were employed in positions of civilian management with the Department of the Navy. You were a member of the Grievance Advisory Board of the Quonset Naval Air Station and, for a time, Chairman of the Executive Board of the American Federation of Government Employees, AFL-CIO. In 1954 you received the second highest civilian award, the Navy's Meritorious Civilian Service Award, plus several other awards of merit during your Navy civilian career. You are a past President of the Urban League of Rhode Island. a former member of the Board of Directors of the Providence Branch of the NAACP, former Chairman of the Rhode Island Committee on Discrimination in Housing, and former Vice Chairman of Citizens United for Fair Housing. In 1968, you received the Bronze Brotherhood Award of the Southern New England Conference of Christians and Jews. Many of the projects for which you labored so long have come to fruition, but you have never given up the fight for what remains to be done. As Director of the Rhode Island Department of Community Affairs, you are continuing your efforts in an even broader scope of activity for the benefit of all the people of the State.
