HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENTS

David Maraniss

HONORARY DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS



David Maraniss, an associate editor at *The Washington Post*, and a Pulitzer Prize-winning journalist and author whose writing has been hailed by the *International Herald Tribune* as bringing "to mind the versatility and depth of David Halberstam," will deliver the keynote address to graduating seniors and their guests.

Maraniss is the author of *Barack Obama: The Story*, considered one of the most notable books of 2012 by *The New York Times* Book Review. He is the author of such critically acclaimed best-sellers as: *When Pride Still Mattered: A Life of Vince Lombardi; First in His Class: A Biography of Bill Clinton; They Marched Into Sunlight – War and Peace, Vietnam and America, October 1967; Clemente – The Passion and Grace of Baseball's Last Hero; and Rome 1960: The Summer Olympics That Stirred the World.* He is also the author of Into the Story: A Writer's Journey Through Life, Politics, Sports and Loss; and The Clinton Enigma.

As a reporter for *The Washington Post*, Maraniss was awarded the Pulitzer Prize for National Reporting for his stories about the life and career of candidate Bill Clinton in the 1992 campaign for the U.S. presidency. He also was part of the team that won a 2008 Pulitzer for the newspaper's coverage of the Virginia Tech tragedy. He has won several other notable awards for achievements in journalism, including the George Polk Award, the Dirksen Prize for Congressional Reporting, the ASNE Laventhol Prize for Deadline Writing, the Hancock Prize for Financial Writing, the Anthony Lukas Book Prize, the Frankfurt Book Prize, and the Ambassador Book Prize.

Maraniss attended the University of Wisconsin-Madison, leaving the University in 1975 to work for the *Trenton Times*. He joined *The Washington Post* two years later. He received an honorary degree from the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 2014.

Michael E. Fisher '67

HONORARY DOCTOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

Michael Fisher, managing director (retired) of Barclays Global Investors, began his career in 1967 with Pacific Mutual Life Insurance Company. He subsequently held various management positions in PML subsidiaries including: Pacific Equity Sales, Pacific Investment Management, and PM Life-New York. He served in senior management roles at Chase Investors Management Corporation, Bankers Trust Company, Equitable Life, and Strong Capital Management. In 1999, he joined Barclays Global Investors, one of the world's largest asset managers and a leading provider of investment management products and services. Prior to retiring in 2007, he was involved in the company's iShares exchange traded funds business initiative.



Fisher chaired the Bryant Board of Trustees from 2008 to 2014 after serving on the board from 1992 to 2001. He is a member of the Archway Investment Fund Advisory Board, a charter member of the President's Leadership Council, and served on the Campaign Steering Committee for the first comprehensive capital campaign in school history. With his classmate, Bill Conaty '67, he co-chairs the current capital campaign, Expanding the World of Opportunity: The Campaign for Bryant's Bold Future.

Fisher and his wife, Karen, have been generous supporters of Bryant for many years, most recently establishing the Karen L. and Michael E. Fisher Scholarship for Athletic and Academic Excellence. In recognition of their leadership and financial support, Bryant dedicated its transformed student center in their honor. The Michael E. '67 and Karen L. Fisher Student Center, a lasting tribute to the Fishers, has become the heart of the Bryant campus and a welcoming destination for all who visit.

Fisher played on Bryant's varsity basketball team from 1963-64. He is a former president of the Association of Investment Management Sales Executives and has served on the boards of the Dan Jansen Foundation; W.O.R.L.D. Team Sports; Health Plans, Inc.; Main Management, Inc.; and the Floating Hospital of New York.

Helena B. Foulkes

HONORARY DOCTOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION



In 2014, Helena Foulkes, executive vice president of CVS Health and president of CVS/pharmacy since 2009, was named one of *Fortune Magazine's* Most Powerful Women in Business. Foulkes is helping to shape the nation's healthcare landscape through innovation and a commitment to CVS Health's purpose of helping people on their path to better health. Over the course of her 20-year career with CVS Health, currently the largest pharmacy healthcare provider in the United States, she has amassed an extensive background in retail and healthcare marketing and strategy, and has played a key leadership role in growing the company from its retail roots to its position as industry leader.

Foulkes is credited with numerous innovations including groundbreaking pharmacy healthcare programs that include the largest retail loyalty program in the country, ExtraCare, with more than 70 million active cardholders. She was also at the forefront of the company's decision in 2014 to stop tobacco sales at all pharmacy locations and launch a national smoking cessation program.

Responsible for all aspects of the company's retail business including its more than 7,800 retail stores, 18 distribution centers, and e-commerce sites, as well as merchandising, supply chain, marketing, real estate, front store, and pharmacy operations, Foulkes also manages CVS Health's enterprise digital, brand, and communications teams.

Prior to joining the company in 1992, Foulkes held corporate finance positions at Goldman, Sachs & Co. and Tiffany & Co. She currently serves on the boards of The Home Depot, Dana-Farber Cancer Institute, and The Wheeler School.

Foulkes received her undergraduate degree from Harvard College and an M.B.A. from Harvard Business School. She is the recipient of numerous professional honors and awards.

GRADUATION HONORS AND HONOR SOCIETIES

Students at Bryant University who have distinguished themselves through academic performance wear gold honor cords with their academic robes.

ACADEMIC HONORS

Special recognition is accorded those who show distinction in academic achievement. Honors may be awarded on the basis of cumulative averages, as follows: *Cum Laude* (with honors – GPA of 3.30), *Magna Cum Laude* (with high honors – GPA of 3.55), and *Summa Cum Laude* (with highest honors – GPA of 3.80). Students must have completed sixty (60) semester hours of coursework at Bryant University to be eligible for honors.

hp HONORS PROGRAM

The Bryant University Honors Program provides highly qualified and motivated students with special opportunities to challenge themselves while developing their intellectual abilities and talents through an interdisciplinary curriculum. In order to be considered Honors Program graduates, students must successfully complete a rigorous curriculum of eight honors-level courses, including an Honors Senior Capstone Project. In addition, each student needs to earn a minimum overall GPA of 3.4 and a minimum Honors GPA of 3.2 in his or her coursework.

HONOR SOCIETIES

△ Alpha Kappa Delta – The International Sociology Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, students must have at least junior-year standing, an overall GPA and a sociology GPA of at least 3.0, be in the top 35 percent of their class, and have completed a minimum of four courses in sociology.

ß Beta Gamma Sigma – International Honor Society

This is the highest national recognition a student can receive in an undergraduate program in a business or management program accredited by AACSB International – The Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business. Members must have earned a cumulative GPA of 3.5 and rank in the upper 10 percent of the second-semester junior class, upper 10 percent of the senior class, or top 20 percent of the graduating master's class.

E Kappa Mu Epsilon – Mathematics Specialized Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, students must have completed at least three college semesters and rank in the upper 35 percent of their class. In addition, they must have completed at least three courses in mathematics, including at least one semester of calculus, and attained an average of "B" or better in all mathematics courses.

↑ Lambda Pi Eta – Communication Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, a student must have completed at least 12 hours of communication courses, have a GPA of at least 3.25, and be in the upper 35 percent of the graduating class.

T Mu Kappa Tau – National Marketing Honor Society

In order to qualify for membership, a student must be a junior or a senior marketing major or business concentrator with a marketing minor, and have a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher.

μ Mu Sigma Rho – National Statistics Honorary Society

To be eligible for induction, a student must be a junior or senior, have completed eight semester hours of statistics courses (of which at least five semester hours must be at the junior level or higher), have a 3.25 GPA in all statistics courses, and be in the top third of the class in all coursework.

O Omicron Delta Epsilon - National Economics Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, a student must have chosen economics for his or her major field of concentration, have attained a cumulative average of 3.0 or higher in a minimum of four economics courses, and have received the recommendation of the economics department.

K Omicron Delta Kappa – National Leadership Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, a student must be a junior or senior recognized for excellence in academics (top 35 percent of the class), athletics, community service, mass media, or the performing arts. All members are nominated by current members of the society.

Φ Phi Alpha Theta – The National History Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, a student must earn a minimum GPA of 3.1 in at least 12 semester hours in history and an overall GPA of 3.0, and must also be in the top 35 percent of his or her class.

π Pi Sigma Alpha – The National Political Science Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, students must have completed a minimum of 12 semester hours of political science courses with a minimum GPA of 3.3, as well as an overall minimum GPA of 3.3.

I Phi Sigma Iota – International Foreign Language Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, a student must be pursuing a major, minor, or concentration in one of the languages offered at Bryant (Chinese, French, Italian or Spanish), have completed at least one course at the 300 level (305 or above) and 45 semester hours, have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 overall and a minimum grade point average of 3.5 in his or her language courses, and rank in the top 35 percent of his or her class.

Ψ Psi Chi – The International Honor Society in Psychology

To be eligible for membership, students must have an overall GPA that is in the top 35 percent of their class, an overall grade point average of at least 3.0, and a cumulative average that is at least 3.0 in their psychology courses. Membership is limited to Applied Psychology majors who are at least juniors and have taken a minimum of nine hours of psychology.

Σ Sigma Tau Delta – International English Honor Society

To be eligible for membership in the Alpha Tau Rho Chapter of Sigma Tau Delta, a student must have completed a minimum of two college courses in English language or literature beyond the usual requirements in freshman English. THE HARRIET E. JACOBS MEMORIAL MACE

The University Mace is carried at Commencement exercises and at other University celebrations. Crowned in gold, the mace has two dominant emblems: the seal of the State of Rhode Island and the seal of Bryant University.

THE PRESIDENT'S CHAIR

The President's Chair, a gift to the University from Priscilla Angelo and her husband, John Eng-Wong, is used on ceremonial occasions. It is a Victorian-style gent's chair rendered in walnut and copied from an original French design from the period of the University's founding in 1863. The carved crest top includes the Bryant University bronze seal.

BRYANT MEDALLION

The Bryant Medallion is worn by the president during academic ceremonies such as Commencement, Convocation, and the bestowing of honorary degrees. One side of the medallion bears a likeness of the University seal, the other, the names of all Bryant University presidents. The formal installation of a president is marked by the presentation of the medallion to the president by the chair of the Board of Trustees.

THE BRYANT SEAL

The Bryant Seal represents the educational mission of the University and its worldwide implications. The central symbol is an ellipsoid globe with quills on each side to signify the traditional emblem of communication in business. In the center, behind the globe, is a torch symbolizing liberty, the spirit of free inquiry, academic freedom, and learning. The Archway, forming the background for the globe, torch, and quills, is a University landmark affectionately remembered by thousands of alumni. The Latin motto expresses the purpose of the University: "Cognitio. Virtus. Successus." – Knowledge. Character. Success.

ACADEMIC HERALDRY

The history of academic dress worn today dates back to the universities of the Middle Ages. A statute in 1321 required the wearing of gowns by all scholars and clerics. Probably, the warm gown and hood were practical in the unheated buildings.

Students at most American universities were caps and gowns daily while in residence until after the Civil War. These varied in design until they were standardized by the American Intercollegiate Commission in 1895. While the academic costume code has been modified over the years, the general characteristics of the initial requirements still prevail. The uniform system of academic heraldry serves to indicate the level of degree, the field of study in which it was earned, and the institution by which it was granted.

The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the master's degree has an oblong sleeve and can be worn open or closed. The gown for the doctoral degree has bell-shaped sleeves with black velvet facing down the front and three bars of the same across the sleeves. However, these facings and crossbars may be in the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains.

The academic hoods are lined with the color of the university granting the degree. The length of the hood varies slightly for bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees. It is often traditional for the candidates for degrees to wear the mortarboard tassel on the right front side before the degree is conferred and to shift it to the left when the degree is awarded.

At Bryant University, the president, trustees, and honorary degree recipients wear specially-designed gold robes trimmed with black, representative of the University's colors.
