Jeffrey R. Immelt

HONORARY DOCTOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION



The Commencement keynote speaker will be Jeffrey R. Immelt, Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer for GE. Mr. Immelt has held several global leadership positions since joining the company in 1982, including roles in GE's Plastics, Appliances, and Healthcare businesses. In 1989 he became an officer of GE and joined the GE Capital Board in 1997. He was appointed president and chief executive officer in 2000.

Mr. Immelt has been named one of the "World's Best CEOs" three times by *Barron's*, and GE has been named "America's Most Admired Company" in a poll conducted by *Fortune* magazine, and one of "The World's Most Respected Companies" in polls by *Barron's* and the *Financial Times*. GE has over 300,000 employees in more than 180 countries worldwide.

Mr. Immelt is a member of U.S. President Donald Trump's Committee on American Manufacturing. Under the Obama administration, Mr. Immelt chaired the President's Council on Jobs and Competitiveness. He is a member of the American Academy of Arts & Sciences.

Mr. Immelt earned a Bachelor of Arts in Applied Mathematics from Dartmouth College and a Master of Business Administration from Harvard University.

Shobana Kamineni

HONORARY DOCTOR OF SCIENCE

Shobana Kamineni is the Executive Vice Chairperson of Apollo Hospitals Enterprise Limited and a member of its founding family. The pioneer of private healthcare in India, Apollo Hospitals is Asia's largest health care provider.

Championing special initiatives for more than seven years, Ms. Kamineni steered the organization's emergence as a proponent of integrated healthcare in India. She continues to lead Apollo Global Projects Consultancy and the Research & Innovation divisions. As the head of Apollo Pharmacy, she leads India's largest pharmacy chain with a pan-India network of over 2,500 stores and 19,000 employees. Ms. Kamineni is the founder and a Director on the Board of Apollo Munich Health Insurance, recognized as India's best specialized Health Insurance Company. She serves on a number of boards including Blue Star Limited and Hero MotoCorp., and was an advisor to CISCO's India External Board. She is also involved in a number of civic organizations including the National Cadet Corps (NCC), an organization that recruits cadets for basic military training, and the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), where she serves as the organization's first woman President. In addition, Ms. Kamineni is Vice Chairperson of the KEI Group, a diversified logistics, leisure, and infrastructure business she founded with her husband. She has received prestigious national awards for entrepreneurship and leadership.

Ms. Kamineni received a Bachelor of Arts in Economics from Stella Maris College, Chennai, India, and an accelerated Hospital Administration Diploma from Columbia University.

HONORARY DOCTOR OF LETTERS



Bryant Women's Summit® Co-founder and Director Kati C. Machtley has been dedicated to helping people of all ages to discover and reach their potential since she began her career in higher education as a nursing faculty member in 1974. When she came to Bryant 21 years ago, she learned that the University has recognized the importance of educating women since its founding in 1863. She partnered with four Bryant colleagues to establish the first Women's Summit® in 1997, and for 20 years, the highly anticipated annual event has helped to inspire, educate, and empower thousands of women.

Mrs. Machtley is also co-founder and director of Bryant's annual Interfaith Prayer Breakfast, a Bryant tradition for 21 years. She collaborated with students to create the annual SHE (Student Herstory Event) Conference and the Young Women's Colloquium at Bryant. Her civic engagement also includes helping to forge a partnership between Bryant University, Amica Insurance, and the YWCA to encourage middle school girls to pursue STEM careers. The three organizations joined together to create the YWCA's Fantastic Girtastic Code Company Challenge, a daylong event held at Bryant to interest middle school girls in coding and technology. Mrs. Machtley is the advisor for the Big Brothers and Big Sisters (BBBS) of Bryant, which is part of BBBS of the Ocean State, and she has served on the boards of Girl Scouts of Rhode Island and Meeting Street School.

She holds a Bachelor of Science in Nursing from the University of Maryland and a Master of Science in Nursing Education from the University of Rhode Island.

GRADUATION HONORS AND HONOR SOCIETIES

Students at Bryant University who have distinguished themselves through academic performance wear gold honor cords with their academic robes.

ACADEMIC HONORS

Special recognition is accorded those who show distinction in academic achievement. Honors may be awarded on the basis of cumulative averages, as follows: *Cum Laude* (with honors – GPA of 3.30), *Magna Cum Laude* (with high honors – GPA of 3.55), and *Summa Cum Laude* (with highest honors – GPA of 3.80). Students must have completed sixty (60) semester hours of coursework at Bryant University to be eligible for honors.

hp HONORS PROGRAM

The Bryant University Honors Program provides highly qualified and motivated students with special opportunities to challenge themselves while developing their intellectual abilities and talents through an interdisciplinary curriculum. In order to be considered Honors Program graduates, students must successfully complete a rigorous curriculum of eight honors-level courses, including an Honors Senior Capstone Project. In addition, each student needs to earn a minimum overall GPA of 3.4 and a minimum Honors GPA of 3.2 in his or her coursework.

HONOR SOCIETIES

Δ Alpha Kappa Delta – The International Sociology Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, students must have at least junior-year standing, an overall GPA and a sociology GPA of at least 3.0, be in the top 35 percent of their class, and have completed a minimum of four courses in sociology.

β Beta Gamma Sigma – International Honor Society

This is the highest national recognition a student can receive in an undergraduate program in a business or management program accredited by AACSB International – The Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business. Members must have earned a cumulative GPA of 3.5 and rank in the upper 10 percent of the second-semester junior class, upper 10 percent of the senior class, or top 20 percent of the graduating master's class.

Ε Kappa Mu Epsilon – Mathematics Specialized Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, students must have completed at least three college semesters and rank in the upper 35 percent of their class. In addition, they must have completed at least three courses in mathematics, including at least one semester of calculus, and attained an average of “B” or better in all mathematics courses.

Λ Lambda Pi Eta – Communication Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, a student must have completed at least 12 hours of communication courses, have a GPA of at least 3.25, and be in the upper 35 percent of the graduating class.

T Mu Kappa Tau – National Marketing Honor Society

In order to qualify for membership, a student must be a junior or a senior marketing major or business concentrator with a marketing minor, and have a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher.

μ Mu Sigma Rho – National Statistics Honorary Society

To be eligible for induction, a student must be a junior or senior, have completed eight semester hours of statistics courses (of which at least five semester hours must be at the junior level or higher), have a 3.25 GPA in all statistics courses, and be in the top third of the class in all coursework.

O Omicron Delta Epsilon – National Economics Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, a student must have chosen economics for his or her major field of concentration, have attained a cumulative average of 3.0 or higher in a minimum of four economics courses, and have received the recommendation of the economics department.

K Omicron Delta Kappa – National Leadership Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, a student must be a junior or senior recognized for excellence in academics (top 35 percent of the class), athletics, community service, mass media, or the performing arts. All members are nominated by current members of the society.

π Pi Sigma Alpha – The National Political Science Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, students must have completed a minimum of 12 semester hours of political science courses with a minimum GPA of 3.3, as well as an overall minimum GPA of 3.3.

I Phi Sigma Iota – International Foreign Language Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, a student must be pursuing a major, minor, or concentration in one of the languages offered at Bryant (Chinese, French, Italian or Spanish), have completed at least one course at the 300 level (305 or above) and 45 semester hours, have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 overall and a minimum grade point average of 3.5 in his or her language courses, and rank in the top 35 percent of his or her class.

Ψ *Psi Chi – The International Honor Society in Psychology*

To be eligible for membership, students must have an overall GPA that is in the top 35 percent of their class, an overall grade point average of at least 3.0, and a cumulative average that is at least 3.0 in their psychology courses. Membership is limited to Applied Psychology majors who are at least juniors and have taken a minimum of nine hours of psychology.

Σ *Sigma Tau Delta – International English Honor Society*

To be eligible for membership in the Alpha Tau Rho Chapter of Sigma Tau Delta, a student must have completed a minimum of two college courses in English language or literature beyond the usual requirements in freshman English. The candidate must have a minimum of a “B” or equivalent average in English and in general scholarship, must rank at least in the top 35 percent of her/his class, and must have completed at least three semesters or five quarters of college coursework.

THE HARRIET E. JACOBS MEMORIAL MACE

The University Mace is carried at Commencement exercises and at other University celebrations. Crowned in gold, the mace has two dominant emblems: the seal of the State of Rhode Island and the seal of Bryant University.

THE PRESIDENT'S CHAIR

The President's Chair, a gift to the University from Priscilla Angelo and her husband, John Eng-Wong, is used on ceremonial occasions. It is a Victorian-style gentleman's chair rendered in walnut and copied from an original French design from the period of the University's founding in 1863. The carved crest top includes the Bryant University bronze seal.

BRYANT MEDALLION

The Bryant Medallion is worn by the president during academic ceremonies such as Commencement, Convocation, and the bestowing of honorary degrees. One side of the medallion bears a likeness of the University seal, the other, the names of all Bryant University presidents. The formal installation of a president is marked by the presentation of the medallion to the president by the chair of the Board of Trustees.

THE BRYANT SEAL

The Bryant Seal represents the educational mission of the University and its worldwide implications. The central symbol is an ellipsoid globe with quills on each side to signify the traditional emblem of communication in business. In the center, behind the globe, is a torch symbolizing liberty, the spirit of free inquiry, academic freedom, and learning. The Archway, forming the background for the globe, torch, and quills, is a University landmark affectionately remembered by thousands of alumni. The Latin motto expresses the purpose of the University: "Cognitio. Virtus. Successus." – Knowledge. Character. Success.

ACADEMIC HERALDRY

The history of academic dress worn today dates back to the universities of the Middle Ages. A statute in 1321 required the wearing of gowns by all scholars and clerics. Probably, the warm gown and hood were practical in the unheated buildings.

Students at most American universities wore caps and gowns daily while in residence until after the Civil War. These varied in design until they were standardized by the American Intercollegiate Commission in 1895. While the academic costume code has been modified over the years, the general characteristics of the initial requirements still prevail. The uniform system of academic heraldry serves to indicate the level of degree, the field of study in which it was earned, and the institution by which it was granted.

The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the master's degree has an oblong sleeve and can be worn open or closed. The gown for the doctoral degree has bell-shaped sleeves with black velvet facing down the front and three bars of the same across the sleeves. However, these facings and crossbars may be in the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains.

The academic hoods are lined with the color of the university granting the degree. The length of the hood varies slightly for bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees. It is often traditional for the candidates for degrees to wear the mortarboard tassel on the right front side before the degree is conferred and to shift it to the left when the degree is awarded.

At Bryant University, the president, trustees, and honorary degree recipients wear specially-designed gold robes trimmed with black, representative of the University's colors.
