ATHLETIC ACCOLADES

- The women's volleyball team finished the season 31-12, their second consecutive 30 win season advancing all the way to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA tournament; their first NCAA appearance in the history of the program. Maria Bras '96 and Meribah Dean '96 were selected to the American Volleyball Coaches Association All Region team and the Northeast-10 All Conference team. Maria Bras was selected NE-10 Player of the Year for the second consecutive year, and Jen Carvalho '98 was named freshman of the year.
- Karen Palczynski '96 became the first women's cross country All American since 1986, finishing 21st in the NCAA regionals. The team finished in the top ten in every race this season, including first place finishes at the Shaklette Invitational and the Tri-States Championships. They finished second in the NE-10 Conference and tenth at the NCAA regionals. Heather Cronce '96 was named to the first team All Conference; Karen Palczynski '96 and Jessica Duval '96 were named to the second team.
- The men's soccer team advanced into NE-10 post-season play. Goalkeeper Mike Pavano '96 was named to the Northeast-10 All Conference Team.
